**1 1/2 MILES.**(Turf). 5th Running **THE BREEDERS' CUP TURF** (Grade I). Purse \$2,000,000. 3-year-olds and upward. Weight: 3-year-olds 122 lbs. Older 126 lbs. Fillies and mares allowed 3 lbs. Value of race \$2,000,000. Value to winner \$900,000, second \$450,000, third \$216,000, fourth \$140,000, fifth \$100,000, sixth \$20,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion, winner \$50,000, second \$25,000, third \$12,000; Foal, winner \$50,000, second \$25,000, third \$12,000. Stallion awards will be paid only to the nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through the E.B.F. All unpaid nominator's awards will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited.

**GREAT COMMUNICATOR** saved ground while making the pace, responded readily when outrun for command nearing the stretch and outfinished **SUNSHINE FOREVER** in a stiff drive. The latter prompted the pace while racing just outside **GREAT COMMUNICATOR**, made a bid between horses midway of the final turn, dueled for the lead into the stretch and fought it out gamely. **INDIAN SKIMMER**, rank while being restrained behind the leaders through the stretch the first time and through the run down the backstretch, moved fast from the outside approaching the stretch but wasn't good enough while lugging in under pressure. **TRIPTYCH**, always close up, rallied to reach the front from between horses nearing the stretch but tired during the drive. **MILESIS** failed to reach serious contention. **EL SENOR**, closer than usual early, remained a factor while racing between horses to the final turn and tired badly. **SAINT ANDREWS** tired badly. **SARHOOB** broke slowly and was always outrun. **FRANKLY PERFECT** moved up along the inside before going a half, continued to save ground while remaining a factor to the final turn, then had nothing left and was eased when unable to keep up. **INFAMY** raced forwardly to the second turn while saving ground, stopped badly on the backstretch and was eased late. **UNDERCUT** was scratched due to course condition. **ALL WAGERS ON HIM WERE ORDERED REFUNDED.**
