1 1/4 MILES. (1.46%) 6th Running THE BREEDERS' CUP DISTAFF (Grade I). Purse \$1,000,000. Fillies and Mares. 3-year-olds and upward. Weight: 3-year-olds, 119 lbs., Older, 123 lbs. Value of race \$1,000,000. Value to winner \$450,000, second \$225,000, third \$108,000, fourth \$70,000, fifth \$50,000, sixth \$10,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500, third \$6,000; Foal, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500, third \$6,000.

Stallion awards will be paid only to the nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through the E.B.F. All unpaid nominator's awards will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited. One Supplementary Nomination BAYAKOA.

BAYAKOA, away alertly from the inside, was unhurried when outrun for command by WONDERS DELIGHT, then eased to the outside of that rival entering the backstretch and moved away to a clear lead before going six furlongs, remained well from the rail into the stretch and held GORGEIOUS safe under good handling. GORGEIOUS, reserved early, commenced to rally nearing the end of the backstretch, moved to the inside to continue her bid leaving the far turn and continued on with good courage. OPEN MIND, outrun to the far turn, raced wide into the stretch but failed to seriously threaten with a mild rally. ROSE'S CANTINA, badly outrun early, ducked in while racing wide just after entering the stretch and lacked a further response while coming out late. HIGHEST GLORY, never far back, made a run from the outside at the far turn but was finished entering the stretch. GOODBYE HALO raced wide. NASTIQUE was never close. COLONIAL WATERS, within easy striking distance early, was steadied slightly between horses when outrun by GORGEIOUS midway of the far turn and had nothing left. WINNING COLORS tired badly. WONDERS DELIGHT, hustled along after the start, made the pace into the backstretch while racing well from the rail, held on well to the far turn and stopped badly.
