LASHKARI, never far back while under light restraint, rallied from the outside racing into the far turn and finished strongly to wear down ALL ALONG in a stiff drive. The latter, reserved early, commenced to rally entering the backstretch the final time, took over midway at the far turn and after gaining a clear advantage, wasn't able to withstand the winner. RAAMI commenced to rally soon after going six furlongs, raced wide into the stretch while moving and finished with good courage. STRAWBERRY ROAD II saved ground while making the pace to the final turn, held on well to deep stretch but wasn't good enough. ALPHABATIM quickly reached contention along the inside after breaking slowly, raced forwardly until near the stretch but lacked the needed late response. MAJESTY'S PRINCE failed to be a serious factor. PERSIAN TIARA saved ground to no avail. GATO DEL SOL failed to menace seriously racing wide during the late stages. WHO'S FOR DINNER raced well out in the course while remaining a factor until near the end of the backstretch the final time and gave way. MORCON, prominent to the final turn, tired. TREIZIEME, wide throughout, was finished before going a mile.
