1 1/4 MILES. (1.59%) 7th Running THE BREEDERS' CUP CLASSIC (Grade I). Purse \$3,000,000. 3-year-olds and upward. Weight: 3-year-olds, 121 lbs., Older, 126 lbs. Fillies and mares allowed, 3 lbs. Value of race \$3,000,000. Value to winner, \$1,350,000, second \$675,000, third \$324,000, fourth \$210,000, fifth \$150,000, sixth \$30,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion winner \$75,000, second \$37,500, third \$18,000; Foal winner \$75,000, second \$37,500,

third \$18,000. Stallion awards will be paid only to the nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nomination awards will not be paid to horses eligible through the E.B.F. All unpaid nominator's awards will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited.

UNBRIDLED, away slowly, made a run along the inside leaving the far turn, came out to split the leaders near the final sixteenth and outfinished IBN BEY. The latter, restrained between horses into the backstretch, moved within easy striking distance before going a half, remained a factor into the stretch and continued on with good courage while finishing outside UNBRIDLED and THIRTY SIX RED. THIRTY SIX RED had speed from the outset, saved ground while vying for the lead, gained a clear advantage approaching the stretch but weakened during the drive. LIVELY ONE, outrun to the far turn, was steady while looking for room approaching the stretch, came out after moving through inside horses after straightening away for the drive and finished well. DE ROCHE, unhurried when outrun early, moved through inside horses to reach a striking position entering the stretch but weakened late. IZVESTIA, eased back after breaking alertly, came out between horses to make a run approaching the stretch, then gave way. OPENING VERSE, never far back, rallied from the outside nearing the stretch and flattened out. RHYTHM, outrun into the backstretch, moved up along the inside racing into the far turn, angled out between horses to continue his rally approaching the stretch, then tired badly. MI SELECTO, sent up outside horses nearing the far turn, raced seven wide while continuing to advance approaching the stretch, then had nothing left. BEAU GENIUS, between horses while vying for the lead for seven furlongs, tired badly. FLYING CONTINENTAL raced very wide. DISPERSAL quickly reached contention from the outside, raced forwardly to the far turn and gave way suddenly. HOME AT LAST stopped badly after going six furlongs and was eased late. GO AND GO was finished soon after going a half mile and was eased when unable to keep up.
