TUESDAY (IRE) settled in hand off of the inside, crept to within striking distance through the second turn, came five wide into the stretch, quickened once straightened for the drive, was full bore inside the furlong marker, caught IN ITALIAN (GB) inside the sixteenth marker and kicked away. IN ITALIAN (GB) opened clear to dictate a cracking tempo, kept on doggedly but was unable to resist the winner in the final yards. LADY SPEIGHTSPEARE stalked the pace inside, got through a loomed a danger entering the stretch, toiled on but settled for the minor award. NASHWA (GB) settled saving ground, shifted out and advanced between rivals on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and was making up ground too late. MOIRA was unhurried near the tail of the field, wheeled out six wide entering the lane and improved position. MISE EN SCENE (GB) settled off of the inside, mounted a mild bid between rivals entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. ABOVE THE CURVE was allowed to settle, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten, VIRGINIA JOY (GER) was unhurried, tucked in to save ground, but was never a factor. TOY (IRE) chased three wide, but faltered between foes leaving the second

turn and faded. FAMILY WAY contended three wide through the second turn and dropped out. ROUGIR (FR) failed to respond. GOING TO VEGAS saved ground to little avail.
