Value of race \$1,000,000. Value to winner \$450,000, second \$225,000, third \$108,000, fourth \$70,000, fifth \$50,000 sixth \$10,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500, third \$6,000; Foal, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500,

third, \$6,000. Stallion awards will be paid only to the nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Awards in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through the E. B. F. All unpaid nominator's awards will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited.

MIESQUE, never far back, moved through along the inside approaching the stretch and drew away under a hand ride after taking over from SHOW DANCER. The latter went right to the front, raced slightly out from the rail while making the pace into the stretch and lasted for the place while drifting out during the drive. SONIC LADY, rank early, was steadied along while saving ground through the run down the backstretch, continued along the inside into the stretch and finished with good energy. DEPUTY GOVERNOR, away in good order, dropped back midway along the backstretch, raced well out in the course into the stretch and failed to seriously menace with a mild late response. EXPLOSIVE DARLING moved through between horses after entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. SHORT SLEEVES, well placed to the far turn, made a run from the outside approaching the stretch but weakened under pressure. HIGHEST HONORS, steadied soon after entering the backstretch, moved through along the inside entering the stretch but failed to sustain his rally. TEMPERATE SIL was used up prompting the pace. LE BELVEDERE showed some early foot. SANTELLA MAC raced very wide. AIR DISPLAY was never close. DOUBLE FEINT showed nothing. MILLIGRAM, off slowly, raced wide. DULUTH tired badly.
