Value of race \$1,000,000. Value to winner \$450,000, second \$225,000, third, \$108,000, fourth \$70,000, fifth \$50,000, sixth \$10,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500, third \$6,000; Foal winner \$25,000, second \$12,500,

third \$6,000. Stallion awards will be paid only to the nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through the E.B.F. All unpaid nominator's awards will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited.

ROYAL ACADEMY, taken back early after breaking a bit slowly, raced well back for five furlongs while racing well off the rail, respond to pressure and rapidly closed ground while circling five wide into the stretch, then sustained his run and finished strongly in the middle of the track to wear down ITSALLGREEKTOME in the final strides. ITSALLGREEKTOME, settled in good position along the backstretch, gradually worked his way forward from outside on the turn, drew alongside EXPENSIVE DECISION to challenge at the top of the stretch, surged past that one to gain a narrow advantage leaving the furlong marker, continued in the front into deep stretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. PRIOLO trailed for a half after steadying sharply along the rail entering the backstretch and, finding his best stride, rapidly closed ground from outside entering the stretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track to gain a share. STEINLEN raced in close contention between horses for five furlongs, lagged behind slightly on the turn then improved his position with a mild late run between horses. EXPENSIVE DECISION alternated for the early lead outside SHOT GUN SCOTT, shook off that one to gain a clear advantage midway on the turn, continued on the front end into midstretch then weakened under pressure in the final eighth. WHO'S TO PAY, outrun for six furlongs while saving ground, failed to seriously threaten with a mild rally between horses. MARKOFDISTINCTION raced in traffic while between horses for five furlongs, swung to the outside while rallying on the turn, made a strong run outside the leaders to threaten in midstretch but couldn't sustain his bid. LADY WINNER raced within striking distance while saving ground for five furlongs and lacked a strong closing bid. JALAAJEL was never a factor. GO DUTCH contested the pace from outside for six furlongs then gave way. SHOT GUN SCOTT battled for the lead along the rail for five furlongs and then drifted out while tiring from his early efforts. GREAT NORMAND steadied between horses along the backstretch and was never close thereafter. COLWAY RALLY was finished after going a half.
