Fillies and mares allowed 3 lbs. Value of race \$2,000,000. Value to winner \$900,000, second \$450,000, third \$216,000, fourth \$140,000, fifth \$100,000, sixth \$20,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion, winner \$50,000, second \$25,000, third \$12,000; Foal, winner \$50,000, second

\$25,000, third \$12,000. Stallion awards will be paid only to the nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through the E. B. F. All unpaid nominator's awards will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited.

THEATRICAL, allowed to follow the early leaders, moved fast to reach the front just before going a mile, saved ground after opening a clear lead on the far turn and responded gamely to turn back TREMPOLINO in a long drive. The latter advanced steadily to reach contention while racing well out in the course midway along the backstretch, loomed boldly entering the stretch and continued on with good courage. VILLAGE STAR II, outrun early, commenced to rally after entering the backstretch, angled out for the drive and finished with good energy. VILZAK raced well out in the course while rallying after entering the backstretch, remained a factor to the upper stretch and weakened. LOUIS LE GRAND moved up outside horses on the backstretch, continued wide into the stretch and weakened. STORM ON THE LOOSE lacked a late response while finishing between horses. AUTUMN GLITTER was without speed. ALLEZ MILORD moved through along the inside to reach a striking position approaching the stretch but gave way under pressure. RIVLIA raced very wide during the late stages. CIRCUS PRINCE failed to be a serious factor. SIR HARRY LEWIS raced in closest attendance to GREAT COMMUNICATOR into the backstretch, made a bid along the inside before going a mile, raced forwardly to the stretch and stopped suddenly. GREAT COMMUNICATOR quickly sprinted clear, raced well out from the rail holding a good lead into the backstretch and was finished at the far turn. SWINK was finished early while saving ground. BINT PASHA, close up early, made a run midway along the backstretch but gave way suddenly racing into the far turn.
