Value of race \$1,000,000. Value to winner \$450,000, second \$225,000, third \$108,000, fourth \$70,000, fifth \$50,000, sixth \$10,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500, third \$6,000; Foal, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500, third \$6,000. Stallion awards will be paid only to the nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through the E.B.F. All unpaid nominator's awards will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited.

GULCH came out between horses while moving entering the stretch, loomed boldly leaving the furlong grounds and outfinished PLAY THE KING. The latter, wide into the stretch, made a run approaching midstretch and continued on with good courage in a stiff drive. AFLEET, jostled about between horses after breaking slowly, was outrun into the stretch while saving ground and finished fast along the inside. VERY SUBTLE, prominent from the outset, remained slightly out from the rail while prompting the pace inside OLYMPIC PROSPECT, caught that one soon after straightening for the drive but drifted out while weakening under pressure. PRECISIONIST, close up early while saving ground, angled out for the drive but lacked the needed rally while racing wide during the late stages. MAWSUFF failed to seriously menace while making up ground late from the outside. OLYMPIC PROSPECT showed good early foot while racing well out from the rail, held on well to the final sixteenth and weakened. SYLVAN EXPRESS raced wide. RUHLMANN race forwardly to the turn while saving ground and tired. MINING raced well out in the track while racing forwardly to the stretch and gave way. CALESTOGA was finished early. HIGH BRITE was always outrun while racing wide. READY JET GO had no apparent excuse. ONCE WILD WAS A LATE SCRATCH AND ALL WAGERS INVOLVING ONCE WILD IN THE REGULAR WAGERING AND EXACTA WERE ORDERED REFUNDED. PICK SIX WAGERS ON ONCE WILD WERE SWITCHED TO THE FAVORITE, MINING.
