\$117,000 is the average salary of a cloud professional.<sup>5</sup>

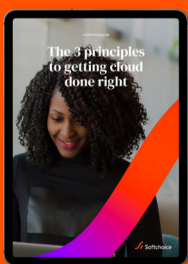
