Finding Notes

The internal NGBs requested to have a modified representational model for their sports. This would allow each of the internal NGBs to have a distinct and sport specific athlete body to raise issues or advocate for athletes in that sport. Unlike other NGBs with multiple disciplines, this model allows each sport to be distinct and includes the understanding that all sports are under the purview of the USOPC. The name being the AAG, while outside the purview of the panel, makes sense as it helps draw a distinction between it and the USOPC AAC that is also housed within the purview of the USOPC.
