Physical Therapy Fellowship



Overview

The USOPC Sports Medicine Physical Therapy (PT) Fellowship is an opportunity for experienced therapists looking to advance their personal and professional growth in sports medicine through a 12-month immersive experience with Team USA. This fellowship is designed to prepare participants for employment in elite-level athletics through a robust curriculum focused on the medical/rehabilitative care of Olympic and Paralympic athletes complimented by high-yield, practical experiences.

The PT fellow will receive one-on-one mentorship from a multi-disciplinary team within USOPC Sports Medicine, provide training and event coverage alongside experienced medical providers, participate in research opportunities based on interest and clinic need, and more.

Eligibility:

There are currently two tracks to be eligible for the fellowship:

1. Completion of a PT residency (sports or orthopedics) with dual credentialing in athletic training OR emergency medical response for the athlete (ERA) training
2. At least three years of clinical practice with board certification as a sports clinical specialist (SCS) or orthopedic clinical specialist (OCS) with dual credentialing in athletic training OR ERA training
