Demographic Data Collection And Preparation

Under Section 220511(2)(B) of the Ted Stevens Act, the USOPC is required to report annual demographic data from the previous year as of December 31. Once the data is collected, the USOPC works with a consultant to compile more than 4,000 data points into unique profiles for each NGB and one for the USOPC.

Significant Definitions

Board of Directors: The Board of Directors is the governing body of a nonprofit. Individuals who sit on the Board are responsible for overseeing the organization's activities.

Standing Committees: A permanent committee of the Board that meets regularly.

Professional Staff: Any paid full-time employee of an NGB.

NGB Membership: All individuals who are paying members of an NGB. This includes grassroots athletes through masters, as well as National Team athletes.

National Teams (Athletes): Athletes who are currently on a National Team as defined by the NGB. This includes the teams selected for that year's national or world championships or the Olympic/Paralympic Games.

National Teams (Coaches and Other Non-Athletes): Staff who assist with the National Teams as defined by the NGB. This includes coaches, trainers, logistics coordinators, medical personnel, etc.

Developmental National Teams (Athletes): Teams typically composed of emerging athletes who are training to eventually compete on the National Teams. These athletes are usually highly skilled individuals who are not fully ready to compete for the National Team.

Developmental National Teams (Coaches and Other Non-Athletes): Staff who assist with the Developmental National Teams as defined by the NGB. This includes coaches, trainers, logistics coordinators, medical personnel, etc.

Part-Time Employees/Interns: These are employees who assist with the operations of an NGB. They differ from professional staff in that they may be temporary or part-time employees.

National Percentages

National percentages are based off the latest data on the American Community Survey (ACS) data updated annually by the U.S. Census Bureau.



Program and Initiative Notes/Highlights

US Figure Skating has established strategic partnerships with organizations that serve communities of color, creating opportunities for greater exposure to and participation in figure skating. Organizations include The Boys and Girls Club, Big Brothers Big Sisters, Jack and Jill of America, diversity-focused skating programs, and minority chambers of commerce. Through these efforts, US Figure Skating has offered informational webinars, ticketing packages to major events, custom office programming, and Skatefest learn-to-skate events. Over the past two years, these initiatives have led to increased membership and fan growth, as well as higher participation in figure skating.

In 2024, US Figure Skating proudly supported the establishment of the first-ever HBCU skating team at Howard University with plans to grow skating opportunities at HBCUs further.




Program and Initiative Notes/Highlights

Year-Over-Year Averages (Past 5-Years)




Program and Initiative Notes/Highlights

US Figure Skating has taken an intentional approach to collect data to better understand the barriers that exist for veterans to improve retention and recruitment efforts. In the past, US Figure Skating has explored partnerships with the VA to support veterans with PTSD by offering therapeutic on-ice classes. More recently, as part of its ongoing commitment to supporting its athletes, coaches and families, US Figure Skating has partnered with O2X Human Performance (O2X) to provide comprehensive resilience and mental performance training across all levels of the sport.


