Psychological Services Fellowship



Overview

The USOPC Sports Medicine Psychological Services Fellowship is an opportunity for mental health professionals in sport looking to advance their personal and professional growth through a 12-month immersive experience with Team USA. This fellowship is designed to prepare participants for employment in elite-level athletics through a robust curriculum focused on the psychological care of Olympic and Paralympic athletes complimented by high-yield, practical experiences.

The Fellow will assist in implementing the clinical pathways for psychological assessment, referrals, treatment/interventions, and management and will serve as a case manager for psychological referrals. They will provide treatment that spans the spectrum of psychological care for athletes, from mental performance to mental health concerns and mental illness.

This role will actively engage in two hours of supervision and one hour of peer case consultation weekly. The Fellow must also be experienced in caring for elite and diverse athlete populations and creating and completing medical documentation. This hybrid role will work regularly from the Colorado Springs Olympic & Paralympic Training Center and remotely.

Eligibility:

- 1.Ph.D/Psy.D in Clinical or Counseling Psychology
- 2. Must be working towards State Licensure as a Psychologist
- 3. Must be working towards or have already obtained the AASP Certified Mental Performance Consultant (CMPC) Certification
