ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE

I. <u>BACKGROUND</u>

On August 9, 2022, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee ("<u>USOPC</u>" or "<u>Complainant</u>") filed a Complaint against USA Skateboarding Federation d/b/a USA Skateboarding ("<u>USAS</u>" or "<u>Respondent</u>") (hereinafter referred to individually as "<u>Party</u>" and collectively as "<u>Parties</u>") pursuant to Section 220521(d) of the Ted Stevens Olympic and Amateur Sports Act (36 USC §§ 220501-220552) (the "<u>Act</u>") and Section 8 of the USOPC Bylaws.

On September 30, 2022, the Hearing Panel issued a Scheduling Order in which a hearing was scheduled for December 19 and 21, 2022.

On December 9, 2022, the Hearing Panel was notified by Holly Shick of the USOPC and confirmed by Stephen Hess, counsel for USA Skateboarding, that the parties had reached a settlement agreement, were withdrawing the Section 8 Complaint and requested that the case be dismissed without prejudice.

II. ORDER

As the parties have reached a settlement in this case, the hearing for December 19 and 21, 2022, is vacated, the Section 8 Complaint is dismissed, and the case is now closed without prejudice.
