AWARD OF ARBITRATORS

This proceeding coming on to be heard upon the demand for arbitration of the United States Wrestling Federation pursuant to Article V, Section 6, of the Constitution, By-Laws and General Rules of the United States Olympic Committee, and the arbitrators having been duly sworn and having heard and considered the extensive oral and documentary evidence submitted by the United States Wrestling Federation and the AAU Wrestling Committee, Amateur Athletic Union of the United States, Inc., also known as the Wrestling Division of the AAU, Inc. and being fully advised in the premises, the Arbitrators hereby make the following Award:

1. The UNITED STATES WRESTLING FEDERATION has established its claim for recognition as the Group A member of the UNITED STATES OLYMPIC COMMITTEE for AMATEUR WRESTLING and is entitled to replace the AAU WRESTLING COMMITTEE, AMATEUR ATHLETIC UNION OF THE UNITED STATES, INC., as such member.
2. The administrative fees and expenses of the American Arbitration Association shall be borne equally by the parties and paid as directed by the Association.
3. The fees for compensation of the Arbitrators shall be borne equally by the parties and paid as directed by the Association.
4. This Award is in full settlement of all claims submitted to this Arbitration.
