### Happening this month...

#### Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> – Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> July

50<sup>th</sup> Karlovy Vary International Film Festival  
Central and Eastern Europe's most prestigious film festival takes place in the Czech Republic, featuring 200 films from around the world. The jubilee edition includes a look at recent Lebanese cinema, a retrospective of the late Soviet-Ukrainian director Larisa Sheptiko's work and tributes to US actors John Cazale and Chris Penn.

#### Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July

Tour de France 2015  
The 102<sup>nd</sup> edition of the world's most famous cycle race is made up of 21 stages and will cover a total distance of 3,360 kilometres. The Grand Départ will begin from Utrecht in the Netherlands, with the Tour spending two days in Belgium before reaching France.

#### Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> – Friday 10<sup>th</sup> July

Paris Haute Couture Fashion Week  
The world's top fashion designers will showcase their handmade creations for Autumn/Winter 2015. The Haute Couture shows, where price tags run into the tens of thousands of euros, only take place in Paris.

#### Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July

The 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the terror attack on London. 56 people were killed and over 700 injured when suicide bombers targeted three London Underground trains and a double-decker bus.

#### Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> – Friday 10<sup>th</sup> July

BRICS Summit  
Meeting of BRICS heads of state and government. The leaders of Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa will meet in Ufa in Russia.

#### Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> July

The 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Srebrenica genocide. More than 8,000 Bosnian Muslim men and boys were systematically massacred and buried in mass graves. Thousands of women, children and elderly people were forcibly deported and a large number of women were raped. It was the greatest atrocity on European soil since the Second World War.

### **Monday 13<sup>th</sup> - Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July**

New York Menswear Fashion Week

Designers including John Varvatos, Ralph Lauren, Calvin Klein and Tommy Hilfiger will present their Spring/Summer 2016 collections.

### **Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> July**

Bastille Day

France celebrates the storming of the Bastille on 14<sup>th</sup> July 1789. The main event is a grand military parade along the Champs-Élysées attended by the President of the Republic and other political leaders. It is accompanied by fireworks and public dances in towns throughout the country. The event symbolises the end of absolute monarchy and the beginning of the Republic.

### **Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July**

The first anniversary of the loss of Malaysia Airlines flight MH17 from Amsterdam to Kuala Lumpur. The aircraft was shot down at high altitude over rebel-held eastern Ukraine. All 298 passengers and crew on board were killed. A Dutch investigation into the cause of the incident will present its findings in October.

### **Friday 31<sup>st</sup> July – Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> August**

Lollapalooza

Paul McCartney, Metallica, Sam Smith and Florence + the Machine are the headline acts at the Lollapalooza music festival taking place in Grant Park, Chicago. Up to 100,000 visitors are expected on each day of the three-day event.

### **Friday 31<sup>st</sup> July**

The election of the Host City of the 2022 Winter Olympics will take place in Kuala Lumpur. The Candidate Cities are Almaty (Kazakhstan) and Beijing (People's Republic of China). Oslo (Norway) withdrew its candidature in October 2014.
