The Holiday Wishes (HW) program provides holiday gifts to youth connected to CPS that you, the caseworkers, submit to the program. Gifts are provided through a combination of community sponsors who receive a child's wishes and monetary contributions used to purchase gifts for the children.

We are excited to launch a new system this year! All children will be submitted in the Holiday Wishes Portal. Please begin to submit your children's wish lists.

Caseworkers can submit a maximum of three wishes totaling approximately \$75-\$100 for each child. Please do not ask for expensive items (i.e. TV, iPad, iPhone) as our donors are very generous and we do not want to take advantage of their generosity.

- Please provide wishes for each child. Children submitted with no wishes or personal information will not be accepted.
- Be sure to indicate any special needs child may have.
- Make wishes as specific as possible, "educational toy" and "age appropriate" is too general
