





Dear parents,

we are very happy that your child will be with us at our **Berlitz Sailing Trip with the sailing ship Swaensborgh.**

To ensure a successful learning experience, we would like you to carefully read the following detailed information about the camp.

Camp address	Berlitz Kids & Teens English Camp Dreimast-Schoner Swaensborgh Sporthafen Blücherbrücke 24105 Kiel
Forms	Valid ID card or passport
Housing	The participants will be accommodated in cabins with 2, 3 or 4 beds . All meals will be prepared together. All cabins have heating and a small washbasin. On board are 5 toilets and 4 showers with running warm and cold water. Additionally, in every harbour, clean and well-kept sanitary facilities with own shower and washrooms are available.
	The beds are freshly covered with a fitted sheet, a freshly covered pillow and a fresh cover. Wi-Fi is available neither on board nor in the harbours. We point out that, if desired, your child must use mobile data.
Additionally to pack	 Scarf, warm socks Weatherproof jacket, trekking shoes, rain jacket, rain trousers Outdoor sport shoes, sturdy sandals (no shoes with heel or leather soles), sports outfit To be prepared against all adversities of wind and weather, we strongly recommend that you also think about weatherproof and warm clothing. Shoes with non-slip soles and without heels should be brought on board – consider weather resistance and interchangeable shoes. As there is not that much space, we recommend using folding bags instead of suitcases. Towel for ship as well as for beach/swimming pool/sanitary facilities (climbing) gloves
Camp program additional information	The language lessons will be integrated in the daily routine as we have to adapt to wind and weather. The itinerary also depends on wind and weather. Because of this, neither the itinerary nor the harbours can be fixed before the camp starts. When



	starting the journey, all predominant wind conditions (direction and strength) are certain.
	Our camp language will be English all day long. The sailing program can take place in English, but due to security reasons it will take place in German.
	Sailing knowledge is not necessary for our adventure. The crew of the ship (Skipper & Mate) will introduce all participants to the most important nautical movements, teach necessary knots and point out the characteristic of the tall ship. All activities on board (setting the sails, docking and casting off) as well as cooking will take place together. All participants are part of the crew and will have the possibility to participate with their support and experience.
Security	The Classification Office ,Register Holland' is responsible for the security on board. It is subject to the international, recognized, Dutch shipping inspection.
	Every year, the safety regulations (salvation, fire safety etc.) and the seaworthiness of the ships is controlled and certified by 'Register Holland'. The ship has, for sure, all salvations such as swimming vests, inflatable life-raft or rubber boat on board. Additionally, the crew has a valid first aid certificate as well as (partly) a live-saving certificate.
Additional information about nutrition	In case of intolerances / allergies, please contact the Berlitz Kids Camp team up to 14 days before the start of the camp. We will check availability.
