

How Marines Use COOL to Earn SANS GIAC Certifications

A Practical Guide for 17XX and Cyber-Adjacent Marines

What Is Navy COOL?

Marine Corps COOL (Credentialing Opportunities On-Line) helps Marines earn industry-recognized certifications that align with their MOS — often with funding support for exam vouchers.

For cyber Marines, this means you can use COOL to pursue GIAC certifications that directly support your operational mission.

Why GIAC?

GIAC certifications validate real-world cyber skills in:

- Defensive Cyber Operations (DCO)
- Offensive Cyber Operations (OCO)
- Incident Response & Threat Hunting
- Enterprise Security & Architecture
- Cyber Leadership

For 17XX Marines, GIAC certifications:

- Reinforce MOS-aligned technical credibility
- Strengthen Cyber Mission Force readiness
- Support billet qualification and advancement
- Provide transition-ready credentials

Defensive Cyber (1721 / MCEN Defense):

- SEC503 → GCIA
- SEC504 → GCIH
- SEC511 → GCED
- FOR508 → GCFA

Offensive Cyber (1711 / CMF Support):

- SEC560 → GPEN
- SEC660 → GXPN
- FOR610 → GREM
- SEC573 → GWAPT

Cyber Leadership (1702):

- MGT512 → GSLC
- SEC530 → GDSA

How it Works (5 Steps)

1. **Identify the Credential aligned to your MOS and billet.**
2. **Verify Eligibility in Marine Corps COOL.**
3. **Request Funding for the certification exam voucher.**
4. **Complete SANS Training to prepare.**
5. **Pass the GIAC Exam.**



Why This Matters to Your Command

GIAC certifications:

- Provide measurable readiness signals
- Align to DoD cyber workforce roles
- Demonstrate technical depth
- Support mission assurance and operational credibility

Call to Action

If you are in a cyber billet:

1. Identify a GIAC certification aligned to your mission.
2. Confirm eligibility in COOL & Submit your funding request.
3. Schedule SANS training & Commit to passing the exam.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: Can I use COOL near separation?

A: Yes, within defined eligibility timelines. Verify in the COOL portal.

Q: Does COOL pay for SANS training?

A: COOL typically funds certification exam vouchers; training may require separate funding.

Q: Do I have to take SANS to earn GIAC?

A: No, but SANS training is purpose-built to prepare you for the exam and operational application.

Q: Is GIAC recognized outside the Marine Corps?

A: Yes, across DoD, federal agencies, and private industry.

Q: Does this help with 8140 alignment?

A: Many GIAC certifications align to DoD cyber workforce roles.
