



# Home Safety Checklist

To help you keep your guests and your home safe, we recommend regularly reviewing the items on this checklist and taking the suggested actions.

**Emergency card**

Review your emergency card and make sure it's got the most up-to-date info for your guests.

**Smoke alarms**

Check that your devices work and have fresh batteries. Check your local rules for where you should install device(s)—generally at least 1 on every floor and outside every sleeping area.

**Carbon monoxide alarms**

Check that your devices work and have fresh batteries. Check your local rules for where you should install device(s)—generally at least 1 on every floor and outside every sleeping area.

**Fire extinguisher(s)**

Check the pressure gauge and expiration date.

**First aid kit**

Replace expired items and replenish supplies, like bandages, as needed.

**Emergency evacuation kit**

Replace expired items and replenish supplies, like water or food, as needed.

**Evacuation plan**

Review your evacuation plan and make sure it has the most up-to-date information and provide any necessary items like emergency ladder, evacuation map, and/or meeting location.

**Heating systems**

Have chimneys and vents inspected and cleaned by a professional.

**Water heater**

Check that the temperature is set to a safe level.

**Gas and electrical appliances**

Check that appliances are working properly and safely, as advised by the manufacturer.
