Our network.

The St. Luke's Health Partners network is the most sought-after health network in the state of Idaho. Why? Because it includes access to all of the St. Luke's health professionals plus an even wider network of trusted independent practitioners as well. In total, members will have access to a network of 4,000+ doctors and specialists trusted by Idahoans. Our network is experienced in providing outstanding health and financial outcomes to more than 260,000 people across the coverage area.

Our coverage.

St. Luke's Health Plan is available in 20 counties in Idaho.

To receive the highest level of benefits, members should try to use services covered within St. Luke's Health Plan areas of coverage. St. Luke's Health Plan members and dependents have access to an extended network, often referred to as the wrap network, outside of the coverage areas. However, services in these areas are typically covered at a lower benefit level.

Members and dependents that live, work or travel outside the St. Luke's Health Plan areas of coverage have three options for care:

- Travel to St. Luke's Health Plan coverage areas for all non-urgent and non-emergency care
- Utilize a provider who is out-of-network for both St. Luke's Health Plan and the wrap network (note: if a member or dependent chooses this option, they are responsible for the full cost of services)
- Utilize St. Luke's OnDemand Virtual Care to video chat with a doctor or therapist at an in-network benefit level



Our benefits.

By offering \$0 copays on primary and preventive care visits, St. Luke's Health Plan members enjoy peace of mind that they'll have fewer barriers to accessing high-quality, affordable care. Beyond great health care coverage, our plans also provide options for members to enroll in Health Savings Accounts (HSA), employee assistance programs, OnDemand Virtual Care, lifestyle medicine options and more.

\$0 benefits on most plans include:

- \$0 primary care physician visits
- \$0 preventive care
- \$0 maternity care (physician charges for routine office visits, delivery and routine postpartum office visits)
- \$0 preventative prescription drugs
- \$0 behavioral health (physician charges for outpatient and inpatient care)
- \$0 preferred generic drugs

We also cover many wellness benefits, including:

- Wellness visits (One per year)
- Flu vaccines (One per year)
- Health advisor program (As needed)
- Cervical cancer screening (Once every 3-5 years)
- Colorectal cancer screening (One per year)
- Breast cancer screening (Once every two years)

There are no limits on several services, including:

- Behavioral health visits
- Physical therapy visits
- Diagnostic lab and X-ray services
