PONTOON 21



HOW TO PLAY

The player makes a Match the Dealer wager by placing a bet in the Match the Dealer bet circle. In order to play Match the Dealer, the player must make a Pontoon 21 bet. If either or both a player's first two cards exactly match the dealer's up card in rank (four matches a four, jack matches only jack, queen matches only queen, etc.), the player wins an amount per the table payoff below.

The minimum bet is \$5, the house sets the maximum.

THE FUN IS BACK

Uses Spanish Decks A-9, J, Q, K (no 10s)

PLAYER BLACKJACK

Always BEATS dealer's Blackjack - pays 3/2

PAIR SPLITTING

A player may split cards of equal value including ACES creating up to four hands. Hitting and doubling of split hands including ACES - is allowed.

DOUBLE DOWN

Double with two or more cards, on any total including after splitting. NO bonuses on doubled hands.

DOUBLE DOWN RESCUE

After doubling, if a player is dissatisfied with his non-busted hand, he may Rescue (take back) the last DOUBLED portion of the bet, forfeiting half of the total wager.

*BONUS 21 PAYS

7+	Card 21	Pays 3-1
6-7-8	Mixed	Pays 3-2
6-7-8	Suited	Pays 2-1
6-7-8	Spaded	Pays 3-1
7-7-7	Mixed	Pays 3-2
7-7-7	Suited	Pays 2-1
7-7-7	Spaded	Pays 3-1

MATCH SUPER BONUS

One Non-Suited Match	Pays 3-1
Two Non-Suited Matches	Pays 6-1
One Suited Match	Pays 12-1
One Non-Suited Match and One Suited Match	Pays 15-1
Two Suited Matches	Pays 21-1

SUPER BONUS

Player holds suited 7-7-7. Dealer up card any 7 **\$5-24 Bet WINS \$1,000 \$25+ , Bet WINS \$5,000**

Envy Bonus - All other betting players get \$50. NO side bet required. Splitting/Doubling VOIDS SUPER BONUS

BONUS SPIN

In order to win on the \$5 Bonus Spin side bet:

Players must have an Ace in their first two cards and are paid even money; or Players must have a Pontoon 21 Blackjack in their first two cards (not after splits) and are paid the denomination won from spinning the wheel at the end of the round.
