TOURNAMENT INFO

1. Players start with 30,000 in tournament chips, including the optional staff add-on.
2. Levels change every 20 minutes.
3. Late registration and re-entries permitted until the start of level 7.
4. The \$300 buy-in is broken down as: \$215 of each entry goes to the prize pool, \$25 is withheld for house revenue, \$35 is for Road to Aria FreeRoll to be held June 4, and \$25 is a voluntary staff add-on. The add-on will be available at the time of registration, at the cashier cage.
5. MGMNH no longer withholds any fees for staff gratuity. A voluntary gratuity of \$25 for the staff will render you eligible for a bonus of 10,000 starting chips (addon). This is an optional gratuity that will be provided directly to the staff and will not be kept by the house.

HOUSE RULES

1. Must be an MGM rewards member to participate.
2. Must be 21 years or older to participate.
3. MGM National Harbor Poker Room reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel any tournament.
4. MGM National Harbor Poker Room operates under TDA rules (www.pokertda.com).
5. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Pursuant to IRS regulations, w-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings that are \$5,000 over the buy in amount.
6. Multiple buy-ins may be aggregated and deducted from the proceeds to determine the winnings from a wager.
7. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to tax withholdings.
8. Discourteous behavior and abusive language towards team members or players will not be tolerated.
9. Tournament Director's decision is final.
10. Tournament play is 9-handed. Play will begin with 4 active players at the table.
