

POKER RULES



- MGM Grand Detroit requests all initial buy-ins be handled at the Poker Room Cage.
- Smoking, smokeless tobacco, vapor, e-cigarettes and hookah are prohibited in the Poker Room.
- MGM Grand Detroit has the sole right to control seating at all times.
- MGM Grand Detroit reserves the right to require two players to play at different tables (i.e. husband/wife, relatives, business partners, etc.)
- To protect an existing game, a “must move” may be enforced on starting a new game of the same limit.
- Only English is to be spoken during any game in the Poker Room.
- Management reserves the right to make any decision in the spirit of fairness for all players.
- Players must keep their cards in full view of the dealer at all times.
- Players are entitled to a clear view of his/her opponents chips.
- A player who fails to take reasonable means to protect their hand shall have no recourse if their hand becomes fouled or the Dealer accidentally collects the hand.
- Higher denomination chips must be visible to all players at all times.
- A maximum of three raises will be allowed on limited games.
- A Player may expose their card(s) with action remaining when heads up only. At no time do we allow a player to expose their cards when there are three (3) players or more remaining in the hand.
- It is the responsibility of all players to immediately call attention to mistakes that happen on the table. Once the first card is dealt on the next hand, there is no recourse on the previous hand.
- Talk or action demeaning to the Dealer or Player will not be tolerated. Throwing cards, name-calling and other such uncivilized behavior will be grounds for suspending or barring any Player from the card room
- All disputes in which a ruling, interpretation, clarification or intervention is required, the decision of the Poker Room Manager is final.
- The promotional meter is funded from every pot reaching a minimum of \$20.00. When the pot reaches \$20.00, \$2.00 is placed in the promo drop box.
