General Rules

- 1. The \$1,600 Buy-in is allocated as follows: \$1,420 to Prize Pool; \$115 House Fee; \$65 Voluntary Staff gratuity.
- 2. ARIA Poker does not withhold any percentage of the prize pool for Staff gratuities. A voluntary Staff gratuity of \$65, at registration only, will grant players an additional 20,000 in starting chips. This is an optional gratuity that will be provided directly to the Staff and will not be kept by the House.
- 3. Players will start with 40,000 tournament chips, including the optional Staff Gratuity. (20,000 + 20,000)
- 4. Levels will be thirty (30) minutes in length. (20 minutes when heads up play is reached)
- 5. Players with pre-purchased seats will have their chips put into play at the beginning of the tournament. Unseated alternates will have their chips put into play at Registration Close.
- 6. Ante is posted by the Big Blind ONLY. Big Blind is posted prior to Ante.
- 7. Players may buy-in and re-enter through the end of level 9, including Break. Tournament Surrender will be allowed on Level 9 break.
- 8. Fifteen (15) minute breaks will be every 3 levels.
- Payout structure based on number of entries and will be approximately 12.5% of field.
- 10. Tournament will be played 8-handed. Final Table is 9-handed.
- 11. ARIA guarantees the Prize Pool to be at least \$500,000.
- 12. Management reserves the right to cancel or change tournaments.
- 13. Tournaments will use TDA rules.
- 14. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- 15. All players must use their ID and Player's Club Card to enter the tournament.
