## BORGATA POKER OPEN MIXED GAME MINI-SERIES LEADERBOARD CHALLENGE

The Borgata Poker Open Mixed Game Mini-Series Leaderboard Challenge will offer any player participating in a designated Tournament Event the opportunity to accrue points which will be applied to a Leaderboard. The following Borgata Poker Open Main Events will qualify for the Leaderboard Challenge and any associated Leaderboard Points:

Event 2: Omaha H/L Championship on Tuesday, September 3, 2024;

Event 4: H.O.S.E Championship on Wednesday, September 4, 2024;

Event 6: Big O H/L Championship on Thursday, September 5, 2024;

Event 9: Deuce to Seven Triple Draw Championship on Friday, September 6, 2024;

Event 12: 8 Max PLO Mix Championship on Saturday, September 7, 2024;

Event 15: H.E.R.O.S. Championship on Sunday, September 8, 2024;

Event 18: Pot Limit Omaha Championship on Monday, September 9, 2024;

Event 20: Dealer's Choice Championship on Tuesday, September 10, 2024; and

Event 21: 8 Game Mix Championship on Wednesday, September 11, 2024.



Registration and Placement data pulled from the BRAVO Tournament Watch system will determine the top players based on total points accrued in all qualifying events. A \$5 contribution will be made as part of every buy-in and re-entry into a qualifying event to the Leaderboard Prize Pool which Borgata will 100% match, doubling the final total of the Leaderboard Prize Pool. The Borgata Poker Open Mixed Game Mini-Series Leaderboard Challenge will pay out the total accumulated Leaderboard Prize Pool in CASH to the top five (5) players in the following manner: 1st Place: 30% of the Prize Pool; 2nd Place: 25% of the Prize Pool; 3nd Place: 20% of the Prize Pool; 4th Place: 15% of the Prize Pool; 5th Place: 10% of the Prize Pool.

Example: The total combined entries for all 9 qualifying events offered in the Mixed Game Mini-Series is finalized at 2,650. A total of \$13,250 was contributed from Player Buy-Ins and Borgata 100% matched the collection, generating a \$26,500 Prize Pool for The Borgata Poker Open Mixed Game Mini-Series Leaderboard Challenge, which will be paid to the top 5 players on the Leaderboard, in cash, in the amounts of: \$7,950 to  $1^{st}$  Place; \$6,625 to  $2^{nd}$  Place; \$5,300 to  $3^{rd}$  Place; \$3,975 to  $4^{th}$  Place and \$2,650 to  $5^{th}$  Place.

Players will accumulate points for participating in the Borgata Poker Open Mixed Game Mini-Series Leaderboard Challenge in two (2) ways:

Placement Points: Placement Points are awarded only to players who are in a prize determined place ("Cash"). Players cashing in the Top 8 will receive Placement Points based on total number of entries in the event. Players cashing below Top 8 will receive the applicable FLAT Placement Points. Players who are not in a prize determined position will not receive Placement Points. The amount of Placement Points awarded to each player will be based on the number of total entries for a qualifying event and that player's finishing place.

If Players opt for an Adjusted Payout (CHOP) of the Tournament Prize Pool, Placement Points will be awarded based on the allocated split with the highest paid player earning the highest Place and thereby, the Placement Points associated with that Place. If the Adjusted Payouts are equal, the Placement Points for the designated payout Places will be combined and split equally between the players who are accepting an equal payout for different Places. If for any reason, the highest paid player is not the player with the highest chip stack, placement points will be awarded at the discretion of the Tournament Director, up to and including an equal split or an allocation based on the size of a player's chip stack at the time of the CHOP. If at any time it is determined that a player or players are manipulating prize pools, adjusted payouts or placement points, the player(s) will be penalized, up to and including disqualification from the Leaderboard Challenge.

Example: Event 4 has 118 entries. When 4 players remain, they agree to an Adjusted Payout (CHOP.) 1st and 2nd Place agree to an even \$10,000 payout each. 3rd Place agrees to a \$6,500 payout and 4th Place agrees to a \$5,130 payout. 3rd Place and 4th Place will still earn 7.2 and 6.3 points, respectively, even though the amount of their payout has increased due to the Adjusted Payout agreement. However, 1st and 2nd Place will each earn 8.5 points based on their equal payout amounts, which is 9 - 1st place points and 8.1 - 2nd Place points, added, and divided equally between the two players.

Buy-In & Re-Entry Points: Players will earn 1 point for their original Buy-In. Players Re-Entering will earn ½ the original Buy-In point amount for each Re-Entry. There are Unlimited re-entries.

Updates: Leaderboard Points will be publicly posted at 9 a.m. Daily beginning Wednesday, September 4. Once the Leaderboard Placement is finalized on Thursday, September 12, 2024, players may collect their prize at the Borgata Poker Open Registration Desk any time after 2 P.M. If a tie exists in Point Totals between two or more players, the total amount set to be awarded to the players finishing with equal point totals will be combined and split equally.
