

ENERGY

- MGM Resorts Mega Solar Array provides up to 90% of daytime power needs for our Las Vegas venues.
- Reduced energy use by 23.9% per square foot since 2007
- Installed more than 1.4 million LED lights in one of America's largest lighting retrofit projects.
- Invested tens of millions of dollars in HVAC efficiency projects.



ENVIRONMENTALLY SUSTAINABLE BUILDINGS

• Nearly all of our resorts have achieved one or more green operations certifications, including LEED, Green Key, and Green Globes for Existing Buildings.

MATERIAL DIVISION

- · MGM Resorts is committed to reducing materials sent to landfills by 60% by 2025
- Our program has diverted over 650,000 tons of materials bound for landfills since 2007.
- Over 30 disposable materials are hand sorted in our back of house to maximize impact, including food waste.

WATER RESILIENCE

- Nearly 99% of water used inside MGM Resorts destinations in Las Vegas is treated and returned to Lake Mead and the Colorado River.
- Replaced over 200,000 square feet of grass turf with drought-tolerant landscaping.
- Close to 14 billion gallons of water saved since 2007 due to conservation efforts.

FOOD DONATIONS


- Unserved catered food from conventions and events are safely donated to our communities through local partners.
- More than 3.5 million meals donated since 2016. ٠
- Since 2007, we have diverted 280,000 tons of food material from landfills including food to charity, food to pig farms, compost, and grease to biofuel.
- · Food waste is a significant focus of our sustainability program, and is aligned with the United States EPA Food Recovery Hierarchy.
