Tournament Rules

- 1. Players start with 15,000 in tournament chips including the voluntary staff add on.
- 2. Blind levels last 15 minutes.
- 3. Registration will open at 11:00am each day and remain open until the beginning of level 4.
- 4. Players with chips in play may purchase a \$20 optional add on for an additional 10,000 in tournament chips prior to the close of registration.
- 5. Players must have chips in play in order to purchase an add on. Players that do not purchase the add on and no longer have chips in play will be ineligible to add on and will be eliminated from the tournament.
- 6. Add on chips must be purchased prior to the start of hand.
- 7. 100% of the funds received from add on purchases will go directly to the prize pool.
- 8. Players will receive a \$25 bounty prize for each player they eliminate from the tournament. Bounty prizes will be issued to a qualifying player once the tournament is completed or they are eliminated.
- 9. Eliminated players may re-enter until the close of registration. Re-entries will be considered a new bounty.
- 10. TDA Rules will be in effect for this event.
- 11. A minimum of 3 tables will be dedicated to this event.

- 12. The \$120 buy in will be allocated as follows; \$65 entry fee, \$25 will go towards bounty prizes; \$20 administrative fees; \$10 voluntary staff add on.
- 13. A voluntary gratuity of \$10 for the staff will render each player eligible for a bonus of 5,000 in starting chips. The bonus tournament starting chips available are included in the starting chip amount listed in Rule #1. This is an optional gratuity that will be provided directly to the staff and will not be kept by the house. Beau Rivage will no longer withhold any portion of buy-ins for staff gratuities.
- 14. All players must be 21 years of age or older to participate, and have a valid, unexpired I.D. and an MGM Rewards player's account. MGM Rewards cards are free and can be obtained at the MGM Rewards desk located at the west end of the casino floor.
