1. Players receive points based on finishing position in all tournament fund eligible events. Prizes are funded by the Tournament Promotional Fund. In all Tournament Fund eligible events, 2% of the prize pool will be withheld.
2. Players must place “in the money” in an eligible 2026 Summer Poker Festival event to receive points. Players will receive multipliers on earned points based on the following factors: Place, Field Size and Buy-in. Points for placing begin at minimum cash payouts. See page 2 for details.

Tournament Leaderboard Rules

1. You must be at least 21 years of age to participate. The Promotional funds collected from each eligible tournament will be 2% of the total prize pool. The Promotional contribution taken from each tournament will be held to accumulate separated from the live action promotions. One hundred percent (100%) of the tournament promotional fund will be posted to the tournament reserve account daily. The tournament promotional reserve account will be used to fund Tournament High Hand payouts, Tournament Leaderboard and other tournament specific promotions.
2. Players participating in eligible poker tournaments are eligible to receive a prize. Live action games will not be eligible.
3. To qualify for the Tournament Leaderboard, players must earn cash in tournaments for which a tournament fund is collected. Tournaments that do not collect a tournament fund will not qualify for High Hands or Leaderboard points.
4. **No Limit Hold'em Leaderboard Eligible Events include: 2026 Summer Poker Festival Event # 2, 4-7, 10, 12, 15-20, 23-25, 27, 34, 36-37, 39, 41, 45, 47-48, 51 and all 9pm \$160 NLH Events.**
5. **Mixed Omaha Leaderboard Eligible Events include: 2026 Summer Poker Festival Event # 3, 8-9, 11, 13-14, 21, 26, 28-30, 32-33, 38, 42-43 and 49-50.**
6. **Ladies events, Seniors events, HORSE and TORSE will be ineligible for Leaderboard points.**
7. Leaderboard points will accumulate based on placing in eligible Summer Poker Festival events. Players will receive multipliers on those points based on Place, Field Size and Buy-in.

9. In the event of a leaderboard tie, the players will split the cash prize. If a seat is also being awarded, the tied players will both receive a seat. When there is a Leaderboard Tie, the following place will be skipped. EX/ If two players tie for 6th place, there will be no 7th place finisher. The next player will finish in 8th place. In the event of a "Chop" or "ICM" split of prize pool, Leaderboard points will be awarded based on placement which is tied only to the prize pool amount earned by the finishing player.
10. Any discrepancies in the normal process of a hand including any discussion of potential points awarded, pot size, or solicitation to call a bet during the play of the hands, in the discretion of Management, may void the High Hand eligibility for that hand or void leaderboard points.
11. IRS regulations require U.S. citizens to present valid identification and a social security number.
12. For U.S. Citizens, a 1099-MISC will be issued for all promotional winnings of \$2,000 or more and tournament winnings over \$5,000 will also have 24% withholding applied. Non-resident aliens without a tax treaty are subject to 30% withholding on 100% of all promotional winnings of \$2,000 or more and will be issued a 1042-S. The decisions of MGM Grand management regarding all aspects of this promotion are final and binding, subject to NRS 463.362 which governs this promotion.
