Gridiron Giveaways

- 1. You must be at least 21 years of age to participate in the Mystery Gridiron Giveaways.
- 2. Mystery Gridiron Giveaways Prizes will be funded by the Promotional Reserve Account.
- 3. Eligible Players will have the opportunity to win the chance to draw a Mystery Gridiron Giveaways Prize.
 - a. An Eligible Player is any player who is actively playing on an Eligible Game.
 - i. Players that sit out of a hand will be placed in lobby immediately prior to the start of the next hand. EX/ When a player leaves their chair, the player will be placed in lobby exactly before the dealer begins a new shuffle. Guests are returned from lobby when they accept a hand when returning to the table. Any player in Lobby at the time of the Mystery Gridiron Giveaways is not an Eligible Player and is not qualified to win a Mystery Gridiron Giveaways Prize.
 - ii. Players logged in as "guests" will remain active and be an Eligible Player. These "guests" must create an MGM account to draw for a prize.
- 4. Eligible Games include any poker game for which a Promotional Fund contribution is collected for purposes of funding the Promotional Reserve Account.
 - a. Promotional Funds will be maximum \$2 drawn from the pot of each game, consisting of:
 - i. \$1 taken on the flop; and
 - ii. \$1 taken on a pot of at least \$20.
 - b. Eligible Games do not include cash games with no promotional draw nor games played as part of a Daily Tournament.
- 5. The Mystery Gridiron Giveaways is active September 5th 2024 to January 1st 2025.
- 6. The drawing schedule will be fixed during Professional Football gamedays, specifically Sundays and Mondays.

- 7. Each half hour, one winner will be drawn at random and pull an envelope from the mystery drum. The winners will be drawn at random by approved Bravo poker software, a random seat generator. A poker supervisor will walk the winning player to the mystery drum. Exactly 448 prize envelopes will be placed inside the drum at the start of the football season. The winning guest will draw to reveal the winning prize amount. No prizes that are drawn will be returned to the drum.
- 8. The following prize envelopes will be loaded into the drum before Week 1:
 - a. \$10,000 (2)
 - b. \$5,000 (6)
 - c. \$1,000 (30)
 - d. \$500 (40)
 - e. \$200 (130)
 - f. \$100 (240)



- 9. Once the total 448 envelopes have been removed from the drum, the Mystery Gridiron Giveaways will be complete. Should there be a remainder of envelopes after January 1st, 2025 the Gridiron Giveaway will continue on Sundays and Mondays until the remaining prizes have been drawn.
- 10. Poker Room employees are eligible to participate.
- 11. Reduced rake games are eligible for promotions if a promotional fund is being taken and all other requirements are met.
- 12. Players have the option to not put promotional winnings on the table but can add any amount of the promotional winnings to their stack at the time of the receipt of chips. Chips not in play must be removed from the table. Chips are not in play until received from the MGM Grand Poker Room staff.
- 13. IRS regulations require U.S. citizens to present valid identification and a social security number.
- 14. For U.S. Citizens, Form 1099-MISC will be issued for all promotional winnings of \$600 or more. Non-resident aliens without a tax treaty are subject to 30% withholding on 100% of all promotional winnings of \$600 or more and will be issued a 1042-S.
