

## Nightly DOUBLE UP DRAWINGS Hourly Random Seat Drawings Prize Options: \$100/\$200/\$50

June 1<sup>st</sup> - August 31<sup>st</sup> I Sunday-Thursday 4:15pm-11:15pm

Beginning Wednesday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, at 4:15pm, players actively playing in a jackpot eligible Texas Hold'em game will be eligible\* for a random seat drawing. The winner of the random seat drawing will be eligible to claim a \$100 prize, with an option to "Double Up" to a \$200 prize! Players who elect to go for the double up will choose red or black before the Dealer turns a card face up. If the card turned face up is the color chosen by the player, their prize will "Double Up" to \$200! If the card is <u>NOT</u> the color chosen, players will be eligible for a \$50 prize.

## **Promotion Rules**

- 1. Players must be actively playing in a jackpot eligible Texas Hold'em Game.
- 2. The promotion is active Sunday through Thursday from 4:15pm-11:15pm.
- 3. Promotion drawings will be held every hour at the times listed below:

- 4. Prize values will be \$50, \$100, or \$200. Only one (1) prize amount will be awarded per drawing.
- 5. Poker staff will utilize the Bravo Random Seat Generator to draw a random table/seat number. The player actively playing in that table/seat will be eligible to win a prize.
- 6. The player in the table/seat selected may choose to claim the initial \$100 prize or to "Double Up."
- 7. Players choosing to "Double Up" will select red or black prior to one (1) card being turned face up. If the card turned up is the color the player selected, they will receive a \$200 prize. If the card turned up is not the color the player selected, they will receive a \$50 prize.
- 8. During a "Double Up" the Dealer will remove the next deck from the shuffler or hand shuffle the current deck if the shuffler has not completed the shuffle of the incoming deck. The Dealer will then cut the cards, use the top card of the deck as a burn card, then turn the second card face up on the table.
- 9. Players must be dealt in the hand that the drawing occurs during.
- 10. All prizes will be paid from the Beau Rivage Poker Room Promotion fund.
- 11. All players must be 21 years of age or older to participate, and have a valid, unexpired I.D. and an MGM Rewards player's account. Player's cards are free and can be obtained from The Player's Club Booth located at the west end of the casino floor.
- 12. Beau Rivage reserves the right to refuse entry to any individual. It further reserves the right to disqualify any player from any prize based upon fraud, dishonesty, disruptive behavior, violation of promotional rules or other misconduct.
