

Limit Omaha 8 or Better Promotion

March 2nd – July 31st I Sunday-Thursday 10:00am-4:00am

When a player is dealt four unpaired cards ranked five or lower, or two Aces and two unpaired cards ranked five or lower, and wins no part of the pot, they will be eligible for a prize. For \$10/\$20 limit games and higher, the prize will be \$100. For games below \$10/\$20 limit, the prize will be \$50.

Promotional Rules

- 1. Players must be playing in a jackpot eligible limit Omaha 8 or better game.
- 2. This promotion is active Monday-Sunday from 10:00am 4:00am.
- 3. The pot must be at least \$50 to qualify.
- 4. There will be a maximum of five (5) payouts on each individual day this promotion is active.
- 5. The hand must play to a showdown and any player with an eligible hand must still have a live hand.
- 6. A player may not receive any portion of the main pot or any pot(s) in order to be eligible for a prize.
- 7. A player with a prize eligible hand may not disclose the contents of their hand during play of that specific hand. Doing so will void eligibility for this promotion.
- 8. Prizes for this promotion will be paid from the Beau Rivage Omaha Play-Based Promotion Fund.
- 9. At least one jackpot dollar must be rake on the hand in order to qualify.
- 10. All players must be 21 years of age of older to participate and have a valid, unexpired I.D. and an MGM Rewards Player's account. Player's cards are free and can be obtained from The Player's Club Booth located on the west end of the casino floor.
- 11. For the purposes of this promotion, a hand containing 3 or more aces will not be eligible to win the promotion.
- 12. Beau Rivage reserves the right to refuse entry to any individual. It further reserves the right to disqualify any player from any prize based upon fraud, dishonesty, disruptive behavior, violation of promotional rules or other misconduct.
- 13. Any vendor or immediate family of a vendor who provides promotional items for a tournament, promotion or drawing shall be prohibited from participating in that activity.
