



# **“Let it Ride” DOUBLE DOWN \$2K Max Payout High Hands**



1. The promotion is only active in jackpot funded **Texas Hold'em** and **Omaha** games.
2. This promotion will be active **May 25st, 2025**, through **May 31st, 2025** during the times listed. Any player who makes a hand of **Aces Full of Deuces** or greater, playing two hole cards, will be eligible to win a prize. **Omaha** players must use the **flop only** to create their best promo eligible hand.
3. Players must play their best possible 5 card hand and must win the pot in order to be eligible for a prize.
4. A hand must begin during a session's eligible time listed to qualify for that session's prize.
5. To establish eligibility for a session's prize, a hand will be considered to have started when the dealer removes the deck from the shuffler or begins the hand shuffling procedures.
6. Discrepancies concerning the time a hand started will be subject to surveillance review.
7. In the event that the Bad Beat Jackpot is triggered during the hand, the hand will not qualify for the “Let it Ride” High Hand and the Bad Beat Jackpot will take precedence.
8. Prizes start at **\$500** for each 30-minute session. (All sessions are listed on the back of this sheet)
9. At the end of the 30-minute session the winner will have two choices:
  - a. Accept the prize - The winner will be paid the current prize amount and the high hand will reset to the minimum qualifier (Aces full of deuces or better)
  - b. Let it ride – The current high hand will remain on the board and **\$500** will be added to the prize amount, however if their hand is beaten during the “Let It Ride” session they will not win any prize.
10. Players will only be allowed to “Let It Ride” three times for a maximum prize of **\$2000 (\$500 - \$1000 - \$1500 - \$2000)**
11. If a player's hand is beaten after a player has “Let It Ride” the prize for the new qualifying hand will reset to \$500.
12. During this promotion all hands that are currently in progress at the end of a session will only be eligible for the next sessions prize.
13. There will be **no ties** during this event, a player must beat the current high hand in order to be eligible for a prize.
14. In the event that two players win the high hand during a chopped pot, they will each be paid out \$500 at the end of that session and there will be no option to “Let It Ride”.
15. **If a Royal Flush is hit, the winner will immediately be paid out the maximum amount (\$2000) of the promotion and the high hand will be reset at the end of the current session.**
16. Suit will be used to determine the rank of a Straight Flush. Suit rank from lowest to highest is Clubs, Diamonds, Hearts, Spades.
17. Poker games must be raked and have a minimum of 4 (four) players in order to qualify.
18. At least one Jackpot dollar must be dropped on the hand in question in order to qualify.
19. **All players must be 21 years of age or older to participate and must be able to provide valid, unexpired identification in order to claim the prize.**
20. Players must be present at the completion of a session in order to claim a prize.
21. All players must have an MGM Rewards Card in order to qualify for the promotion.
22. MGM Springfield reserves the right to refuse entry to any individual. It further reserves the right to disqualify any player from any prize based upon fraud, dishonesty, violation of promotion rules or other misconduct.
23. MGM Springfield will provide tax forms and will withhold taxes, in compliance to Massachusetts State and Federal regulations. All winners must produce a valid, unexpired photo ID per IRS regulation.
