



## Early Lion Gets the Spin

1. Only Texas Hold'em cash games are eligible for the High Hand Promotional payouts. Cash games that do not add to the Promotion rake and Daily Tournaments are excluded from all live action promotions.
2. You must be at least 21 years of age to participate. The Promotional funds from every game will be a max of \$3 with \$1 being taken on the flop, \$20 pot size and \$30 pot size. The Promotion rake taken from each game pot will be placed in a drop box on the opposite side of the table from the House rake. The Promotion rake Drop box will be collected and counted in a manner consistent with the internal control procedures of the MGM Grand Poker Room. One hundred percent (100%) of the daily Promotion rake will be posted to the Promotion reserve account daily. The Promotion reserve account will be used to fund the High Hand payouts and other promotions.
3. Eligible Players will have the opportunity to win an Early Lion Drawing Prize.
  - a. An Eligible Player is any player who is actively playing on an Eligible Game.
    - i. Players that sit out of a hand will be placed in lobby immediately prior to the start of the next hand. EX/ When a player leaves their chair, the player will be placed in lobby exactly before the dealer begins a new shuffle. Guests are returned from lobby when they accept a hand when returning to the table. Any player in Lobby at the time of the Early Lion Drawing is not an Eligible Player and is not qualified to win an Early Lion Drawing Prize. Players logged in as "guests" are eligible provided they are not in lobby at the time of an Early Lion Drawing.

#### 4. Ticketing Procedure:

- a. **Beginning at 6:00am on each drawing day, Eligible players (not in lobby) will receive one (1) raffle ticket every thirty (30) minutes with the final ticket being dispensed at 10:00am. Players will retain one half of the ticket. The other half of the ticket will be loaded into a drawing drum to be pulled at random at the times described in rule 5.**
- b. **A poker staff member will draw one (1) ticket and announce to the poker room the winning number at least three (3) times. If one (1) minute passes and no eligible player has produced a winning ticket, the poker staff member will discard the ticket, then draw for two (2) individual ticket winners during the next scheduled drawing. For the 11:15am drawing, the drawing will continue until a winner is awarded the final prize. Tickets verified as winning tickets will be removed from the drum and discarded.**
- c. **The drum will be emptied, and tickets discarded before the next drawing day.**
- d. **Players are eligible for a maximum of 9 raffle tickets on any given drawing day.**

#### 5. Drawing Schedule and Payouts:

- a. **Monday through Friday @ 9:15am, 9:45am, 10:15am, = One (1) Wheel Spin**

6. Reduced rake games are eligible for promotions if a promotional fund is being taken and all other requirements are met.
7. Poker Room employees will not be eligible for the Early Lion Drawings, on or off shift.
8. Players have the option to not put promotional winnings on the table but can add any amount of the promotional winnings to their stack at the time of the receipt of chips. Chips not in play must be removed from the table. Chips are not in play until received from the MGM Grand Poker Room staff.
9. IRS regulations require U.S. citizens to present valid identification and a social security number.
10. For U.S. Citizens, Form 1099-MISC will be issued for all promotional winnings of \$600 or more. Non-resident aliens without a tax treaty are subject to 30% withholding on 100% of all promotional winnings of \$600 or more and will be issued a 1042-S. The decisions of MGM Grand management regarding all aspects of this promotion are final and binding, subject to NRS 463.362 which governs this promotion.
