



Professional Football Squares

September 8th – January 10th 2026

1. You must be at least 21 years of age to participate.
2. The Promotional fund is the amount taken from every eligible poker game pot to fund Poker Room Promotions. A maximum of \$2 will be taken from every pot with \$1 taken on the flop and \$1 taken on a \$20 pot size.
3. The Promotional fund taken from each game pot will be placed in a drop box. The Promotional funds will be collected in a manner consistent with the internal control procedures of the MGM Grand Poker Room.
4. A promotional fund will be added to the Promotional reserve account and fund all present and future promotions. Cash games that do not contribute to the Promotional fund and Daily Tournaments will not be considered “Eligible Games”.
5. This event will be active only during select games. Players can visit the poker room or Bravo Poker Live for the list of eligible games.
6. **There is no limit to the total number of squares a player can earn.**
7. **Guests can qualify for squares through the following methods:**
 - a. **DAILY Live Play –**
 - i. **Tuesdays to Saturdays beginning at 8:00am, the first 16 players reaching 2 hours of Live Play (Minus Lobby Time) and confirm with a poker supervisor, will receive one (1) square.**
 - b. **WEEKLY Live Play –**
 - i. **Tuesdays to Saturdays from 10:00am to 6:00pm, the first 10 players to reach 20 hours of Live Play (Minus Lobby Time) and confirm with a poker supervisor, will receive two (2) squares.**
 - c. **Gameday –**
 - i. **In the event there are unclaimed or vacant squares on Gameday, beginning at 6:00am, any player making a Flush or Better will receive one (1) square. This will continue until all squares have been filled OR 30 minutes prior to kickoff, whichever comes first.**
8. **Any discrepancies or decisions on which players will be granted squares rest with the Shift Manager on duty. Their decision is final.**
9. ****It is every player’s responsibility to approach a staff member for their square once they have eclipsed the daily or weekly necessary hours played to be awarded squares. These squares will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis****
10. A total of 100 square options will be available to players. Players must select a square that is not occupied. Copies of the final grids will be distributed once the game begins. A grid will also be on display in the poker room. The poker room will utilize one 100-square grid for ALL eligible games for the week. The period of measurement is listed above in Rule 7. In the event of an eligible Monday night game, players earning hours toward squares from Tuesday to Saturday will apply to eligible games on the following Sunday and/or Monday. Every Tuesday, hours are reset for the next weekly selected games.
11. In the event there are two (2) eligible games in one calendar day, one grid for squares will be assembled for both games before the first game kickoff. “Score values” that return prizes for guests for the Home/Away teams will be randomly assigned by a poker supervisor. Before the second game kickoff, a poker supervisor will re-draw for new “Score Values” for the Home/Away Teams.
12. Players must match the value of their squares with the last digit of the score at the end of each quarter to win the prize. EX/ My square is “9” for the home team and “6” for the away team. At the end of the third quarter, the scores reflect “19” for the home team and “16” for the away team, I have won the third quarter prize. If the scores reflect “29” for the home team and “6” for the away team, I will also win.
13. Squares/Prizes:
 - a. First quarter square pays **\$450.**
 - b. Second quarter square pays **\$450.**
 - c. Third quarter square pays **\$450.**
 - d. Fourth quarter square pays **\$1,000.**
 - e. Overtime score pays **\$1,000.**



14. At each quarter's end, players in lobby or not logged in with a Player's Card will not be eligible for a prize. Players that are determined to be excessively lobbying to avoid play or to maintain eligibility for squares are subject to having their chips picked up, regardless of whether there is an active list for that game.
15. Prizes for squares will roll to the following quarter if unclaimed. Once each quarter ends and a winner is determined, winners have one (1) minute to claim their prize, or they will not be paid, and the prize will roll to the next quarter/square winner.
 - a. In the event there is no clear winner for the 4th Quarter or Overtime square, the prize will roll to the 1st Quarter of the next eligible Game. **All squares/quarter prizes will roll until capped at \$1,750.**
16. It is every player's responsibility to realize the full number of hours played before leaving the poker room for the day. Any discrepancies will be handled on a case-by-case basis and there will be no guarantee that hours will be retroactively added to a player's account. **Guests will be placed into lobby after they miss a hand.**
17. Reduced rake games are eligible for promotions if a promotion rake is being taken and all other requirements are met.
18. IRS regulations require U.S. citizens to present valid identification and a social security number, if applicable.
19. Players may not earn hours for another guest or play using another guest's card and doing so will result in forfeiture of hours earned, and possible disqualification from the entire promotion, for all players involved.
20. Poker room employees are eligible to participate, off clock only.
21. Players have the option to not put promotional winnings on the table but can add any amount of the promotional winnings to their stack at the time of the receipt of chips. Chips not in play must be removed from the table. Chips are not in play until received from the MGM Grand Poker Room staff.
22. For U.S. Citizens, Form 1099-MISC will be issued for all promotional winnings of \$2,000 or more. Non-resident aliens without a tax treaty are subject to 30% withholding on 100% of all promotional winnings of \$2,000 or more and will be issued a 1042-S. The decisions of MGM Grand management regarding all aspects of this promotion are final and binding, subject to NRS 463.362 which governs this promotion.
23. The MGM Grand reserves the right to modify or discontinue this promotion at any time.
