EARN POINTS FOR CASHING IN THE MGM GRAND POKER ROOM TOURNAMENTS!!

- 1. Players receive points based on cashing position in all tournament fund eligible events.
- 2. Players must win money to receive points.
- 3. Prizes are funded by the Tournament Fund. In all Tournament Fund eligible events, \$5 will be withheld.
- 4. Tournament entries into future events are non-refundable. Players winning multiple seats may transfer their second seat for cash. This event will conclude with the final scheduled tournament on December 5th, 2025.
- 5. In any event where the tournament prize pool is altered due to player agreements (ICM) points will be distributed based on ICM payouts. In the event of a tie for the final payouts, players will chop the payout.
- 6. Players will receive points at a 10% conversion, cash to points. Ex/ a \$575 cash will net 57.5 points. Players will receive 10 points for every registered tournament PLUS points for cashing.
- 7. The points leaderboard will be posted daily in the poker room.
- 8. Tournament High Hands will be active during Daily Tournaments for which a tournament fund is collected. See reverse side for full details.

Tournament Leaderboard and High Hand Rules

- 1. You must be at least 21 years of age to participate. The Promotional funds from each tournament will be \$5 per registered player. The Promotion rake taken from each tournament will be held to accumulate separated from the live action promotional rake. One hundred percent (100%) of the tournament promotional rake will be posted to the tournament reserve account daily. The tournament promotional reserve account will be used to fund Tournament High Hand payouts and other tournament specific promotions.
- 2. Only players that are participating in poker tournaments are eligible to receive a prize. Live action games will not be eligible. Tournament High Hands will be active during poker tournaments only.
- 3. There is no minimum pot size to qualify. Hands do not have to go to showdown.
- 4. To qualify for the Tournament High Hands promotion, qualifying hands will be Quads or better. The player's best possible combination of five cards will determine the hand. Players that tie the board will qualify. Players must utilize a pocket pair to qualify for quads and both hole cards to qualify for Straight and Royal Flushes.
- 5. Tournament High Hand payouts:
 - a. Quads \$25
 - b. Straight Flushes and Royal Flushes \$50
- 6. To qualify for the Tournament Leaderboard, players must earn cash in daily tournaments for which a tournament fund is collected. Tournaments that do not collect a tournament fund will not qualify for High Hands or Leaderboard points.
- 7. Leaderboard points will accumulate based on cashes in daily tournaments. The conversion rate will be 10%, cashes to points. Ex/ A \$575 cash in a daily tournament will net 57.5 points. Points leaderboards will be posted in the poker room, daily. Players will receive 10 points for every registered tournament PLUS points for cashing.
- 8. In the event of a leaderboard tie, the players will split the cash prize. If a seat is also being awarded, the tied players will both receive a seat. If two players are tied for a place, the following place will be skipped. EX/ If two players tie for 6th place, there will be no 7th place finisher. The next player will finish in 8th place.
- 9. Players winning a seat into a future event will have their starting stack placed in level 1 and blinded off until the chips are gone. Players will not receive a cash prize in lieu of a winning seat. The seats are non-refundable. However, in the rare event a player has won two seats into the same event, the player is eligible for a cash payment for the second seat. If the winning player would prefer to play a second flight into a multi-flight event, this option will also be permitted, whenever available.
- 10. Any discrepancies in the normal process of a hand including any discussion of possible Tournament High Hands, potential points awarded, pot size, or solicitation to call a bet during the play of the hands, in the discretion of Management, may void the High Hand eligibility for that hand or void leaderboard points.
- 11. Poker Room employees are eligible to participate, off shift only.
- 12. IRS regulations require U.S. citizens to present valid identification and a social security number.
- 13. For U.S. Citizens, a 1099-MISC will be issued for all promotional winnings of \$600 or more and tournament winnings over \$5,000 will also have 24% withholding applied. Non-resident aliens without a tax treaty are subject to 30% withholding on 100% of all promotional winnings of \$600 or more and will be issued a 1042-S. The decisions of MGM Grand management regarding all aspects of this promotion are final and binding, subject to NRS 463.362 which governs this promotion.
- 14. Cash prizes unclaimed by December 21st @ 5:00pm will be returned to the promotional pool.
- 15. The MGM Grand reserves the right to modify or discontinue this promotion at any time.
