


OPTIONAL ACTIVITY 2

Baby Sloth vs. Zombies - Complete as many of the challenges below as possible!



CHALLENGE 1: New Heading

1. Open this URL in your internet browser: <https://shortcut.pw/htmlrace>.
2. On the left sidebar, click “index.html”.
3. On the top bar, click “Show”, and select “Next to The Code” from the dropdown menu.
4. Read the story in the right window.
5. Think of:
 - A new main character to replace “Edna the sloth”
 - A new enemy to replace the zombies
6. In the HTML editing box on the left, change the Heading of the story (**HINT:** It’s located between `<h1></h1>`). It should automatically reflect your changes in the right window.

CHALLENGE 2: New Character Image

1. Open a new Tab in your browser.
2. Find an image using Google Image Search to use for your new main character.
3. Click on the image you want to use to open it.
4. Right click the image, and select “Copy image address”.
5. Go back to the activity website in your browser.
6. Find the first image of Edna the sloth in the code, and replace it with your new image URL.

CHALLENGE 3: Change Colour

Change the body background colour from black (#000000) to a new colour.

Easy for you? Bonus challenges - Change the heading 1 background colour and the unordered list background colour.

HINTS:

- Need help getting the code for the colour you want? Open a new tab and search for “HTML colour picker”.
- Colour codes are usually preceded by a # symbol. Colours in HTML have 6 digit hex codes. Examples:
 - “Red” = #FF0000
 - “White” = #FFFFFF

CHALLENGE 4: Change the story content (the words!)

- Replace the entire story with a story of your own.
- Do not change any code - just edit the CONTENT

HINT: The content of the page is all in the <body> section and appears in black text.

CHALLENGE 5: List the names of the people in your family

1. Using code, create a bulleted list at the bottom of the page that has the first names of everyone in your family, as separate bullets.
2. It should look like this in the preview window.

Story by:

- Patricia
- Rob
- Sarah
- Rachel

HINT: You might be able to find another bulleted list in the code that you can copy and paste to make your new list.

CHALLENGE 6: Add 1 link

1. Take any 2 words or phrases in your story and turn them into a link to a website.
2. Example: You could link the word “sloth” to a Wikipedia article about sloths.

HINT: Search www.w3schools.com for “HTML links” to find example code you can use!
