

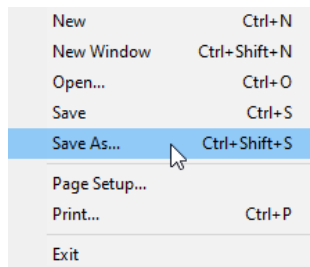
OPTIONAL ACTIVITY 1

You were able to unscramble the HTML using the puzzle pieces – but do you want to see what it looks like on a computer?

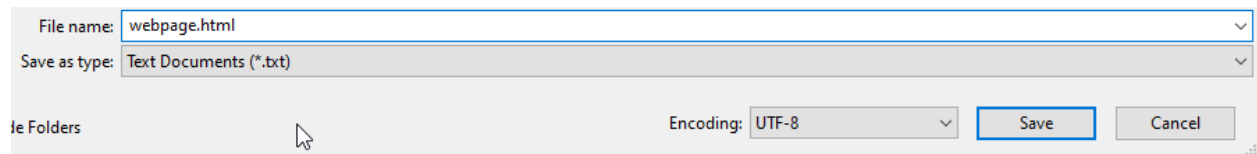
1. Launch a text editor program on your computer (e.g. Notepad for PC, or TextEditor for Mac).
2. In the text editor program, type out the HTML exactly as it appears below.

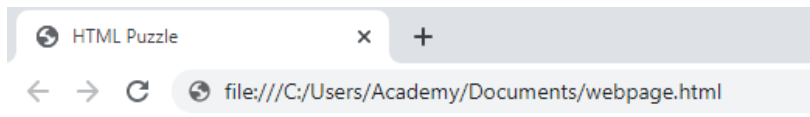
3. Now, save it as a webpage. Click on File in the top-left menu and hit Save As. Don't forget where you saved it!



4. Give your webpage a name, but make sure you include .html at the end. This way your computer will know it's opening a webpage.



5. Head to where you saved your webpage. Since you saved the webpage as a .html file, it will open in your internet browser when you click on it. The internet browser will read the HTML, and open as a webpage.
