BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Following Saturday's Rutgers/Mississippi State game, Big Ten teams will take a hiatus for the Christmas holiday. The
 games will resume on Thursday, Dec. 28, with Maryland hosting Coppin State. Nine teams will see action on Dec.
 29, with Dec. 30 marking the final day of nonconference contests. There will be no games on Dec. 31-Jan. 1, with
 conference play set to resume on Tuesday, Jan. 2.
- Three Big Ten teams were included in both the AP and USA Today Coaches Polls this week. Purdue returned to the No. 1 spot in both polls, while Illinois moved up to No. 13 and 11, respectively, with Wisconsin sitting at No. 24 in both rankings. Michigan State and Ohio State received votes in both polls, while Northwestern earned mention in the media poll and Nebraska in the coaches poll.
- With 12 conference games in the books, the Big Ten has returned to nonconference action through the end of the 2023
 calendar year. Four teams, Indiana, Northwestern, Illinois, and Wisconsin are a combined 5-0 on the young season,
 while lowa and Michigan State both stand at 0-2. The league's final nonconference contests are scheduled for Saturday,
 Dec. 30, with a return to Big Ten action slated for Tuesday, Jan. 2.
- After going 12-3 last week, the Big Ten improved to 91-34 in nonconference action. Its 91 wins ranked fifth most among all conferences behind the Big 12 (115-29), Atlantic 10 (106-53), SEC (103-43), and ACC (98-41). However, its .728win percentage lists behind only the Big 12 (.797). Among the league's 91 victories were nine wins over AP Top 25 opponents, most of any conference.
- The Big Ten went 12-3 in nonconference action last week, including an impressive 7-2 on Saturday. The day was
 highlighted by Purdue's 92-84 win over then-No. 1 Arizona at the Indy Classic. It was the Boilermakers' first win over
 a number one ranked team since Nov. 25, 2000, when it also defeated Arizona in Indianapolis. Sophomores Fletcher
 Loyer and Braden Smith and senior Zach Edey combined for 75 points, marking the first time three Purdue players
 have scored 20 or more points since Nov. 20, 2021, vs. North Carolina and for just the seventh time since the 1979-80
- Michigan State also put up a dominant performance in scoring an 88-64 win over then-No. 6 Baylor in Detroit. The
 Spartans led 45-47 at the half and shot a season-high 63.3 percent from the field, including 8-12 from three-point range,
 to win the Continental Tire Motor City Invitational. It was the first time the team shot at least 60 percent from the floor
 since Dec. 31, 2017 against Savannah State. Graduate student Tyson Walker paired a game-high 25 points with five
 steals to lead three Spartans in double-figure scoring.
- Purdue sophomore Fletcher Loyer was named Big Ten Player of the Week after scoring a career-high 27 points in the Boilermakers' 92-84 win over then-No. 1 Arizona. The sophomore guard shot 11-18 from the floor, including 5-9 from three-point range, and added a career best four steals.
- lowa's Owen Freeman collected his fourth Big Ten Freshman of the Week honor after pairing 14 points and 11 rebounds in just 19 minutes of action in an 88-54 win over Florida A&M. Freeman became the first lowa freshman to record a double-double since Joe Wieskamp in 2018.
- MILESTONE WATCH... lowa head coach Fran McCaffrey stands just five wins from topping Tom Davis for most victories in program history. Davis collected 271 wins during his 13 seasons in lowa City. The Hawkeyes' first conference win of the season will also break a record with Davis for most Big Ten wins in program history... Maryland head coach Kevin Willard is just two wins shy of his 300th career victory. Willard will become the league's fifth active coach with 300 career wins and join his father, Ralph, who amassed 336 wins as a coach at Western Kentucky, Pitt, and Holy Cross. Willard would join Virginia's Tony Bennett as the only active coaches with 300 wins whose fathers also have 300 victories... Michigan State head coach Steve Izzo owns 693 wins after last night's win over Oakland. Izzo is on the verge of becoming the 10th active coach in Div. I to record 700 career victories.
- Six Big Ten teams rank in the top-50 in Tuesday's NET rankings. Purdue's No. 3 ranking is tops in the league, while Illinois and Wisconsin sit at Nos. 14 and 17 respectively, followed by No. 33 Ohio State, No. 39 Michigan State, and No. 50 Nebraska. The Big 12 boasts a nation-leading eight top-50 entrants, while the Big Ten, Pac 12, and SEC. have six each, one more than the ACC and Mountain West.
- The Big Ten leads the nation with 16 Quad 1 wins and is tied for the lead with 28 Quad 1 and 2 wins through games on Dec. 18. Purdue, Wisconsin, and Michigan State are three of just 11 to have faces at least five Quad 1 opponents, while

the Boilermakers and Spartans are two of six in the country to play at least seven teams in Quads 1 and 2. Only the SEC and SWAC have multiple teams to face at least five quad 1 opponents, while two SEC squads have also played at least seven teams in Quads 1 and 2.

- The Big Ten boasts some of the top defensive teams in the country. Four teams also list in the top 40 in field goal defense, led by Illinois, who holds opponents to .372 shooting, good for sixth in the nation. Rutgers (.376) ranks 15th, followed by Nebraska (.379) in 17th and Michigan State (.393) in 35th. Rutgers, Illinois, and Maryland also rank in the top 40 in scoring defense. The Scarlet Knights surrender just 60.9 points, ninth in Div. I, while the Illini and Terps allow 64.2 and 64.4, respectively which list 36th and 37th. In total, nine teams give up 67.0 or fewer points per game.
- Eight Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-50 in the Kenpom rankings. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by Illinois (#14), Wisconsin (#17), Michigan State (#23), Ohio State (#26), Nebraska (#43), Michigan (#45), and lowa (#50). The conference's eight teams are two behind the Big 12 for the most teams in the top 50. The SEC has seven entrants, one more than the Pac 12 and two more than the ACC and BIG EAST.
- Six Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-50 of the ESPN Strength of Record listing. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by No. 16 Wisconsin, No. 22 Illinois, No. 28 Northwestern, No. 32 Indiana, and No. 49 Ohio State.
- More than 1.5 million fans have watched Big Ten basketball this season, including more than a million fans in our 14 home venues. Seven Big Ten teams rank in the top-25 in total attendance. Nebraska leads the league with 113,356 fans through eight games, third in the country. Michigan State (103,579) and Illinois (100,085) rank fourth and sixth, respectively. Indiana (12th 94,579), Wisconsin (15th 89,488), Maryland (21st 75,278), and Purdue (23rd 74,380) are included in the top 25. In total, 12 Big Ten schools rank in the top 50.
- For the sixth consecutive year, each Big Ten Conference member institution will compete in a 20-game conference schedule. The Big Ten Conference season begins Friday, Dec. 1, when Maryland visits Indiana and Northwestern hosts Purdue, the first of 12 conference games played between Dec. 1-10. Following a break in conference play, Big Ten action will resume on Jan. 2. During the conference season, schools will play seven teams twice once at home and once on the road and six teams once, with three of those games being at home and the other three away.
- The 27th annual Big Ten Tournament will be played at Target Center in Minneapolis between March 13-17, 2024, marking the first time the tournament has been played in Minneapolis. All 14 teams will advance to the tournament, with two 1st round games slated for Wednesday, March 13th. The top four teams will receive 1st and 2nd round byes and advance to the quarterfinals on Friday, March 15th.
- A Big Ten media panel has chosen 2023 Consensus National Player of the Year Zach Edey as 2023-24 Big Ten Men's Basketball Player of the Year. The league's reigning Player of the Year, Edey became the first Boilermaker since Glenn Robinson in 1994 to win National Player of the Year accolades and the fifth Big Ten Player in the last 14 years to be named National Player of the Year joining Evan Turner (2010), Trey Burke (2013), Frank Kaminsky (2015) and Luka Garza (2021) as National Players of the Year.
- The media panel also selected the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team. Edey joined Illinois' Terrence Shannon Jr., Maryland's Jahmir Young, and Northwestern's Boo Buie as unanimous selections. Also named to the team were Maryland's Julian Reese, Minnesota's Dawson Garcia, Michigan State's A.J. Hoggard and Tyson Walker, Nebraska's Keisei Tominaga, and Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi. All ten members of the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team received All-Big Ten honors following the 2022-23 campaign. Buie and Shannon joined Edey with First Team accolades, while Omoruyi, Walker, and Young were named to the Second Team. Hoggard earned a spot on the Third Team, with Garcia, Reese, and Tominaga receiving Honorable Mention.

AROUND THE BIG TEN

Illinois: The Illini currently lead the Big Ten and rank third in the country with 44.8 rebounds per game. Illinois has secured at least 50 rebounds five times this season, including a stretch of four straight games, marking the longest streak of consecutive games with at least 50 rebounds since the 1963-64 season.

Indiana: With two nonconference home games remaining on the schedule, the Hoosiers are a perfect 16-0 against unranked nonconference opponents at Assembly Hall under Mike Woodson. Indiana's last such loss was a 71-64 defeat to Arkansas on Dec. 29, 2019.

lowa: lowa held Florida A&M to 52 points on Saturday – the Rattlers' season low, the fewest lowa has allowed this season and the fewest the Hawkeyes have allowed since 2021. Portland State scored 51 points against lowa on Nov. 26. 2021.

Maryland: The Terps hit the century mark for the second time this season with a 105-65 win over Alcorn State a week ago. Six players hit double figures for the first time since 2018, while the two 100-point games in a season marked a first since 2010-11. The 40-point win margin was also the program's best since defeating Wingate, 100-58, on Jan. 15, 2021.

Michigan: With eight games of 80-plus points (three of 90-plus), Michigan is averaging 82.2 points per game, which ranks third in the Big Ten. The Wolverines have not averaged above 80 points per game since the 1992-93 season (81.94) — Juwan Howard and the Fab Five's freshman season.

Michigan State: The Spartans shot a season-best 63.3 percent from the floor in Saturday's 88-64 win over Baylor. The win marked the first time the team shot at least 60 percent from the floor since Dec. 31, 2017 against Savannah State.

Minnesota: Junior guard Elijah Hawkins dished out a program-record 17 assists in the Gophers' 101-65 win over IUPUI, breaking a nearly 30-year-old mark. The 17 dishers are the most in any Div. I, II, or III game this season. Hawkins now leads the Big Ten and ranks second in the nation with 82 total assists.

Nebraska: The 46 points allowed by Nebraska in its 62-46 win at Kansas State was the lowest in Fred Hoiberg's five seasons and the Huskers' best defensive output since holding Southwest Minnesota State to 38 points on Dec. 29, 2018. It was NU's lowest total allowed to a Division I program since holding Southeastern Louisiana to 36 points on Nov. 11, 2018. The Wildcats entered Sunday averaging 80.9 points per game.

Northwestern: The Wildcats' 56-46 win at DePaul marked the program's first road victory as a ranked team since Jan. 4, 1969, when the No. 19 ranked Wildcats defeated Michigan State 85-71 inside Jenison Field House.

Ohio State: Entering Saturday's game, the Buckeyes have scored at least 80 points in six consecutive games, the program's longest of 80-point outings since early in the 2011-12 season. While Ohio State scored just 67 points in Saturday's win at UCLA, the Buckeyes are already more than halfway to last season's total of 10 games with at least 80 points.

Penn State: Sophomore guard Kanye Clary is leading the Nittany Lions with 17.1 points per game, good for ninth in the Big Ten. Clary has recorded 188 points through 11 games after scoring just 117 in 32 contests during his rookie campaign.

Purdue: Purdue defeated then-No. 1 Arizona 92-84 on Saturday at the Indy Classic. It was the Boilermakers' third all-time win over a top ranked team and their first since beating Arizona on Nov. 25, 2000, a game that also was played in Indianapolis.

Rutgers: Last week, Clifford Omoruyi became the 46th player in program history to record 1,000 career points. The senior forward also ranks eighth all-time in rebounds (758) and seventh in blocked shots (165).

Wisconsin: With wins over Virginia, Marquette, Michigan State, and SMU, the Badgers are one of just 11 teams in the country with at least four Quad 1 and 2 wins and one of just seven with at least three Quad 1 victories.

TIE BREAKER PROCEDURES FOR TOURNAMENT SEEDING

- 1. Teams shall be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the tournament bracket based on the final regular-season Conference standings.
- A team's seed shall correspond to its regular-season finish (i.e., the champion shall be the No. 1 seed, the runner-up the No. 2 seed, etc.).
- Teams that finished Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the regular season shall receive a "bye" through the first two rounds.
- In case of a tie for any place finish in the regular-season standings, the following tie-breaking procedure shall be followed in order to seed teams in the tournament bracket:

- <u>Ties Involving Two Teams</u>

 1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
- Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings (or in the case of a tie for the championship, the next highest position in the regular-season standings), continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
- Won-loss percentage of all Division I opponents.
- Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Ties Involving more than Two Teams

- Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
 - a. When comparing records against the tied teams, teams will be seeded based on winning percentage among the group, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0). If all teams among the group are separated based on winning percentage, all ties are broken. If winning percentage among the group for any tied teams is equal, move to step b with those specific tied teams only (e.g. if there is a four-team tie, one team is 4-0, another is 3-1 and the last two are 2-2 among the group, the two teams that are 2-2 move to step b and the teams that are 4-0 and 3-1 assume the next two available highest seeds).

Note: Teams can be separated from the top, middle or bottom.

- b. If a team or teams are separated from the group based on step a, seeding for remaining teams among the group is not determined by head-to-head record vs. the remaining teams, but rather by taking all remaining teams to next tiebreaker.
- If the remaining teams are still tied, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and ondemand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
