GAME NOTES

ILLINOIS

- Opened a 13-2 lead to start the game, holding Nebraska scoreless for the first five minutes.
- Failed to make a field goal over the last 4:35 of the game.
- Genesis Bryant logged her team-leading 10th 20-point effort of the season; scored in double figures for the 24th time this season and for the 74th time in her career.
- Adalia McKenzie amassed 16 points, six rebounds and 10 assists, playing all 40 minutes.

NEBRASKA

- Advance to tomorrow's quarterfinals with wins against Rutgers and Illinois on back-to-back days; have advanced to a third game in the tournament in three of the past four seasons.
- Rallied for its fifth win this season when trailing by 10-or-more points.
- Claimed first lead (38-37) at 7:16 of the third quarter on a Britt Prince 3-pointer.
- Outscored Illinois, 25-14, in the fourth quarter.
- Seven players had seven-or-more points; finished with a 22-7 advantage in bench points.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Just the sixth time in 31 games that a No. 7 seed has defeated a No. 10 seed at the Big Ten Tournament.
- The closest game of the tournament thus far featured seven lead changes and two ties.
