GAME NOTES

WISCONSIN NOTES

- Sophomore forward Serah Williams broke the Big Ten record with her 16th consecutive double-double behind 10 points and 10 rebounds. She led the team in rebounding for the 20th time this season and for the 30th time in her career.
- Williams leads the Big Ten in rebounds (305).
- Ronnie Porter netted 15 points to lead the Badgers in scoring for the third time this year.

PENN STATE NOTES

- PSU never trailed as the game, leading for 38:53 and tied for 1:07.
- The Lady Lions are 9-0 in games decided by 20+ points.
- Four scorers finished in double-figures with just four points separating the group.
- PSU finished 10-for-11 (.909) from the free throw line.
- Penn State improved its all-time record against Wisconsin to 36-18 and 3-1 in the Big Ten postseason. The Nittany Lions avenged a 69-64 loss to Wisconsin on Feb. 11 in Madison in the lone regular season meeting of 2023-24.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Penn State outscored Wisconsin in bench points, 37-6.
- Game No. 5 produced the biggest margin of victory (24 points) in the Big Ten Tournament thus far.
- No. 7 seeds are now 25-5 versus No. 10 seeds in the tournament.
- Higher seeds have prevailed in all five games of this year's tournament.
