Player of the Week

Matt Butler, Michigan

SR, OF, Lombard, Ill./Driscoll Catholic

Butler batted a sizzling .688 (11-for-16) in a four-game sweep of Oakland to become the first Conference player to earn Big Ten Player of the Week honors twice this season. The senior captain recorded three hits in each of the final three games of the series and reached base 13 times for an on-base percentage of .722. He also drove in five runs and scored three times. Butler, who also picked up League weekly honors on March 7, currently leads the Big Ten in hits (34), doubles (10) and total bases (57) while ranking among the top five in batting average (4th at .436), runs scored (3rd with 22) and RBI (4th with 21).

Co-Pitchers of the Week

Matt Loberg, Minnesota

SR, RHP, Anoka, Minn./Anoka

Loberg pitched eight shutout innings and struck out a career-high nine batters against Butler to become the first Gopher to collect Big Ten Pitcher of the Week laurels this year. The senior righthander allowed only one walk and gave up just four hits in picking up his third win.

Alan Stidfole, Penn State

JR, LHP, New Bloomfield, Pa./Susquenita

Stidfole struck out a career-best 10 batters in 6.1 scoreless innings to lead Penn State to a 1-0 victory at James Madison and earn a share of Pitcher of the Week accolades. The junior lefty allowed only three hits and two walks in the game and joined teammate Craig Clark (February 22) as the second PSU hurler to pick up the weekly award this season.

Big Ten Teams Open Conference Play

The race for the 2005 Big Ten Championship begins this weekend as all 10 Conference teams will take the field to begin the eight-week League season. Minnesota will open its quest for a fourth straight title hosting Michigan, as the Gophers have claimed the last three crowns and also won the Big Ten Tournament last season. Minnesota's last three-peat occurred from 1968-70, as the program has never won four straight championships. The last Conference squad to finish atop the standings in three or more consecutive years was Ohio State, which placed first from 1991-95. The Buckeyes, who have placed second in each of the last three seasons and claimed the Tournament title in 2002 and 2003, open the 2005 slate at Illinois. Other League matchups in the opening weekend include Northwestern at Indiana, Michigan State at Iowa and Penn State at Purdue.
