BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- With the completion of nonconference play on Saturday, the Big Ten will turn its collective focus to conference action through the remainder of the season. The action resumes with three games tonight, as Iowa visits Wisconsin (7 p.m.) and Purdue at Maryland (7 p.m.), while Illinois will host Northwestern at 9 p.m. Four teams, Indiana, Northwestern, Illinois, and Wisconsin are a combined 5-0 on the young season, while Iowa, Michigan State, and Rutgers are seeking their first conference wins.
- Three Big Ten teams were included in both the AP and USA Today Coaches Polls this week. Purdue remained at the No. 1 spot in both polls, while Illinois moved up to Nos. 9 and 8, respectively, with Wisconsin sitting at No. 21 in both rankings. Michigan State and Ohio State received votes in both polls, while Northwestern earned mention in the media poll and Nebraska and Indiana in the coaches poll.
- The Big Ten closed its nonconference slate with a combined 117-37 record. The Big 12 (144-34), SEC (132-47), Atlantic 10 (131-60), and ACC (119-46) collected more wins, but the Big Ten's .760-win percentage falls behind only the Big 12 (.809). Among the Big Ten's 117 victories are 9 wins over AP Top 25 opponents.
- Maryland's Jahmir Young was named Big Ten Player of the Week, presented by Air National Guard, for the weeks of Dec. 18-Jan. 1. Young averaged 30.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists, as the Terps scored wins over Nichols and UCLA. The fifth-year guard paired 23 points and 11 rebounds against Nichols, marking his first double-double of the season. He followed that with a career-high 37 points on 13-19 shooting at UCLA, including a personal 9-0 run to extend Maryland's lead from two points to eight with 1:12 to play. His 37 points are the fourth-most all-time for a Maryland player in a true road game and the most for the Terps since Diamond Stone scored 39 points against Penn State in 2015.
- Indiana's Mackenzie Mgbako was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week for the same period, after averaging 13.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 2.3 assists, as Indiana closed nonconference play with three consecutive wins. Mgbako tallied at least 12 points and five rebounds in all three games, while shooting 40 percent from the field and 90 percent from the free throw line.
- MILESTONE WATCH... Maryland head coach Kevin Willard became the fifth active coach in the Big Ten to reach the 300-win plateau with last week's victory at UCLA. Willard joins his father, Ralph, who amassed 336 wins as a coach at Western Kentucky, Pitt, and Holy Cross. Willard joined Virginia's Tony Bennett as the only active coaches with 300 wins whose fathers also have 300 victories... Iowa head coach Fran McCaffrey stands just three wins from topping Tom Davis for most victories in program history. Davis collected 271 wins during his 13 seasons in Iowa City. The Hawkeyes' first conference win of the season will also break a record with Davis for most Big Ten wins in program history... Michigan State head coach Tom Izzo enters this week's action with 696 wins. Izzo is on the verge of becoming the 10th active coach in Div. I to record 700 career victories.
- Nine Big Ten teams rank in the top-80 in Tuesday's NET rankings. Purdue's No. 3 ranking is tops in the league, while Illinois and Wisconsin sit at Nos. 12 and 17, respectively, followed by No. 29 Michigan State, No. 33 Ohio State, No. 63 Nebraska, No. 67 Iowa, No. 72 Northwestern, and No. 79 Michigan. The Big 12 and ACC lead the nation with 11 top-80 entrants, while the Big Ten, and SEC have nine each, one more than the Big East.
- The Big Ten leads the nation with 15 Quad 1 wins 38 Quad 1 and 2 wins through games on Jan. 1. Purdue, Wisconsin, Michigan, and Michigan State are four of just 10 to have faced at least five Quad 1 opponents, while the Boilermakers, Badgers, Wolverines, and Spartans are four of 13 in the country to play at least seven teams in Quads 1 and 2. Only the Big Ten, SEC and SWAC have multiple teams to face at least five quad 1 opponents.
- The Big Ten boasts some of the top defensive teams in the country. Rutgers leads a trio of Big Ten teams in the top-25 in scoring defense. The Scarlet Knights surrender just 61.4 points per game, good for 11th in the nation, while Northwestern (63.1) and Maryland (63.4) sit 21st and 25th, respectively. Four teams also list in the top 20 in field goal defense, led by Nebraska and Rutgers, who hold their opponents to .374 to rank sixth and seventh in the country, followed by Illinois (.375) in 10th, and Michigan State in 15th (.384). Nebraska (.281), Purdue (.285), and Penn State (.289) also rank in the top-35 in field goal percentage defense.
- Offensively, the Big Ten also ranks among the best in the nation. The conference ranks third in points per game (78.0) and fourth in field goal percentage (.463), while its 2,734 assists rank third. Three Big Ten teams, Iowa (87.8 points per game), Purdue (86.8), Michigan (83.2), and Illinois (82.9) rank ninth, 12th, 35th, and 38th, respectively, in scoring offense, while Purdue (.499), Minnesota (.496), Indiana (49.3), and Michigan (.485) sit in 18th, 22nd, 29th, and 39th,

- Big Ten players also rank in the top-10 in several individual statistical categories. Purdue's Zach Edey ranks fourth in the country with 23.2 points per game and seventh in double-doubles (7). Minnesota's Elijah Hawkins leads the nation with 7.6 assists per contest, while Purdue's Braden Smith (6.7) stands ninth. Defensively, Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi's 3.42 blocked shots per game are good for third, while Penn State's Ace Baldwin Jr.'s 2.69 steals per game rank 10th. A trio of Big Ten players also rank among the top six in assists/turnover ratio, as Michigan State's Tre Holloman (5.12), Ohio State's Bruce Thornton (4.82), and Iowa's Dasonte Bowen (4.56) sit fourth, fifth, and sixth, respectively.
- Eight Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-60 in the Kenpom rankings, including five in the top-30. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by Illinois (#10), Wisconsin (#14), Michigan State (#20), Ohio State (#29), Nebraska (#53), Iowa (#54), and Northwestern (#58). The conference's eight teams are two behind the Big 12 and tied with the Big East and SEC for the most teams in the top-60.
- Six Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-50 of the ESPN Basketball Power Index (BPI) listing. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by No. 12 Illinois, No. 18 Wisconsin, No. 23 Michigan State, No. 31 Ohio State, and No. 50 Iowa. All 14 Big Ten teams also rank in the outlet's top-50 Remaining Strength of Schedule listing.
- More than 1.86 million fans have watched Big Ten basketball this season, including nearly 1.3 million fans in our 14 home venues. Seven Big Ten teams rank in the top-20 in total attendance, including three in the top six. Indiana leads the way with 142,985 fans through nine games, third in the nation. Nebraska (141,730) and Michigan State (133,173) rank fourth and sixth, respectively. Illinois (115,629) checks in at 12th, with Purdue (104,132), Wisconsin (103,592), and Maryland (97,173) sit 17th, 18th, and 19th. In total, 13 Big Ten schools rank in the top 50.
- For the sixth consecutive year, each Big Ten Conference member institution will compete in a 20-game conference schedule. The Big Ten Conference season begins Friday, Dec. 1, when Maryland visits Indiana and Northwestern hosts Purdue, the first of 12 conference games played between Dec. 1-10. Following a break in conference play, Big Ten action will resume on Jan. 2. During the conference season, schools will play seven teams twice -- once at home and once on the road and six teams once, with three of those games being at home and the other three away.
- The 27th annual Big Ten Tournament will be played at Target Center in Minneapolis between March 13-17, 2024, marking the first time the tournament has been played in Minneapolis. All 14 teams will advance to the tournament, with two 1st round games slated for Wednesday, March 13th. The top four teams will receive 1st and 2nd round byes and advance to the quarterfinals on Friday, March 15th.
- A Big Ten media panel has chosen 2023 Consensus National Player of the Year Zach Edey as 2023-24 Big Ten Men's Basketball Player of the Year. The league's reigning Player of the Year, Edey became the first Boilermaker since Glenn Robinson in 1994 to win National Player of the Year accolades and the fifth Big Ten Player in the last 14 years to be named National Player of the Year joining Evan Turner (2010), Trey Burke (2013), Frank Kaminsky (2015) and Luka Garza (2021) as National Players of the Year.
- The media panel also selected the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team. Edey joined Illinois' Terrence Shannon Jr., Maryland's Jahmir Young, and Northwestern's Boo Buie as unanimous selections. Also named to the team were Maryland's Julian Reese, Minnesota's Dawson Garcia, Michigan State's A.J. Hoggard and Tyson Walker, Nebraska's Keisei Tominaga, and Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi. All ten members of the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team received All-Big Ten honors following the 2022-23 campaign. Buie and Shannon joined Edey with First Team accolades, while Omoruyi, Walker, and Young were named to the Second Team. Hoggard earned a spot on the Third Team, with Garcia, Reese, and Tominaga receiving Honorable Mention.

AROUND THE BIG TEN

Illinois: This week's AP No. 9 ranking is the program's highest since March 15, 2021 (#2) and its highest in the first week of January for the Orange and Blue since Jan. 2, 2006 (#6). It also marks the fifth straight season that head coach Brad Underwood has led the Fighting Illini to a top 20 ranking, and the third time in the last four years that the team reached the top 10.

Indiana: Six players scored in double-figures in the Hoosiers' 100-87 win over Kennesaw State on Friday. It was the first time six Hoosiers scored at least in a game since Nov. 30, 2015, when James Blackmon Jr. (33), Thomas Bryant (13), Kevin "Yogi" Ferrell (13), Robert Johnson (12), Troy Williams (11), Collin Hartman (10) did it against Alcorn State.

Iowa: Iowa had three players record double-doubles in its 103-81 win over UMBL — Payton Sandfort (18 points, 10 rebounds), Ben Krikke (17 points, 12 rebounds), and Brock Harding (10 points, 12 assists). It was the first time the team has notched three double-doubles in the same game, while Harding's first career double-double — the first points-assists double-double since 2021.

Maryland: Fifth year forward Donta Scott has scored at least one point in 112 consecutive games, a streak that dates back to March 3, 2020 at Rutgers. In his 140 career games, he has been held scoreless just once, while scoring in double figures 71 times.

Michigan: Dug McDaniel has scored in double-figures in all 13 games this year and leads U-M with 19.0 points per game, fifth in the Big Ten, after having increased his scoring by 10.4 ppg (8.6 to 19.0) from his freshman campaign.

Michigan State: Tyson Walker leads the Spartans and ranks third in the Big Ten and 21st in the country with 20. points per game. Prior to Saturday's win over Indiana State, Walker was one of only three players in Division I averaging at least 19.8 points, 2.9 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.7 steals.

Minnesota: Minnesota's 80-62 win over Maine on Friday improved the team to 10-3 on the season. The Gophers have now notched at least nine nonconference wins in all three seasons under head coach Ben Johnson.

Nebraska: The Huskers enter Wednesday's Indiana game averaging 77.6 points per game. It is NEB's highest points per game average since averaging 80.2 points per game in the 1995-96 season. It is also nearly 10 points per game higher than its average at the 13-game mark in 2002-23.

Northwestern: The Wildcats have been one of the best teams in the country at taking care of the ball this season, leading the Big Ten and ranking fifth nationally, committing just 9.0 turnovers per game. NU's turnover margin of +5.3 per game ranks second in the Big Ten and 10th nationally, while its assist/turnover ratio of 1.89 ranks second in the Big Ten and sixth in the nation.

Ohio State: Jamison Battle has taken (85) and made more three-pointers (36) than anyone in the Big Ten this season. But what is impressive is he is also leading the Big Ten in three-point percentage at a career-best 42.4 percent. He is just seven three-pointers away from 300 in his career.

Penn State: Graduate student Qudus Wahab owns career marks of 1,159 points and 852 rebounds, making him one of just 14 active Division I players with upwards of 1,000 points and 850 rebounds. Wahab currently leads Penn State with 8.8 rebounds per game, while his 9.9 points are good for third.

Purdue: Zach Edey tallied 13 points, seven rebounds, two assists, two blocks and one steal in Purdue's 80-53 win over Eastern Kentucky on Friday. With that output, Edey reached 300 points, 30 blocks and 12 wins in the first 13 games of the season, becoming the first player (college or NBA) since the Lakers' Shaquille O'Neal in 2001-02 to do this.

Rutgers: Senior Clifford Omoruyi has been held without a rebound just once in his 101 career games. It happened on Dec. 23 in a loss to Mississippi State. Omoruyi responded with a 17 point, 17 rebound, three block performance against Stonehill on Saturday. He is the first Rutgers player to achieve that stat line since the start of the 1996-97 season.

Wisconsin: The Badgers have scored at least 70 points in six consecutive games, including 80 points in their win over Chicago State on Dec. 22. Averaging 74.2 points per game this season, Wisconsin is on pace for its highest scoring output since tallying 77.9 points per game in 1993-94.

TIE BREAKER PROCEDURES FOR TOURNAMENT SEEDING

1. Teams shall be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the tournament bracket based on the final regular-season Conference standings.
2. A team's seed shall correspond to its regular-season finish (i.e., the champion shall be the No. 1 seed, the runner-up the No. 2 seed, etc.).
3. Teams that finished Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the regular season shall receive a "bye" through the first two rounds.
4. In case of a tie for any place finish in the regular-season standings, the following tie-breaking procedure shall be followed in order to seed teams in the tournament bracket:

Ties Involving Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
2. Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings (or in the case of a tie for the championship, the next highest position in the regular-season standings), continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of all Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Ties Involving more than Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
 - a. When comparing records against the tied teams, teams will be seeded based on winning percentage among the group, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0). If all teams among the group are separated based on winning percentage, all ties are broken. If winning percentage among the group for any tied teams is equal, move to step b with those specific tied teams only (e.g. if there is a four-team tie, one team is 4-0, another is 3-1 and the last two are 2-2 among the group, the two teams that are 2-2 move to step b and the teams that are 4-0 and 3-1 assume the next two available highest seeds).

Note: Teams can be separated from the top, middle or bottom.
 - b. If a team or teams are separated from the group based on step a, seeding for remaining teams among the group is not determined by head-to-head record vs. the remaining teams, but rather by taking all remaining teams to next tiebreaker.
2. If the remaining teams are still tied, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
