## Co-Players of the Week

### J.R. Kyes, Illinois

### SR, 2B, Springfield, Ill./Southeast

Kyes propelled the Illini to a four-game sweep of Northwestern with four home runs, 13 RBI and nine runs scored to earn Big Ten Co-Player of the Week honors. The senior second baseman batted .529 in the series (9-for-17) and boasted a slugging percentage of 1.471 to help Illinois build its lead atop the League standings. After driving in four runs with a homer in the series opener, Kyes fell just a single short of the cycle in game three and ended the contest with a three-run walk-off blast. He wrapped up the series with two more long balls and five RBI in the finale. Kyes is the fourth Illini to earn Player of the Week laurels this season.

### Joe Kemp, Indiana

### SR, OF, Bowie, Md./Riverdale Baptist

Kemp batted a sizzling .600 (9-for-15) and racked up 11 RBI and nine runs to lead the Hoosiers to their first series victory this season and pick up a share of Player of the Week accolades. The senior outfielder produced a slugging percentage of 1.400 against Michigan State while collecting two doubles, two triples, two home runs, three walks and no strikeouts. The Maryland native hit for the cycle for the first time in his career in the series opener while recording five RBI and four runs. Kemp concluded the series with a 3-for-4 performance with three runs batted in and three runs scored. He collects his second weekly award this season after being honored on March 1.

## Pitcher of the Week

### Tim Gudex, Iowa

### JR, P, Appleton, Wis./North

Gudex picked up the win in both ends of the Saturday doubleheader and closed out the four-game set on Sunday to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Week laurels. The junior reliever rallied the Hawkeyes from a series-opening loss to take three of four from Minnesota and remain second in the League standings. Gudex pitched five and one-third innings on the week, allowing only three hits and no runs while striking out four batters. Despite arriving late to Saturday's games due to illness, he picked up wins by going one and two-thirds of an inning to wrap up each game of the doubleheader and pitched the final inning of the series on Sunday. Gudex earns his second weekly accolade, as he was also honored on April 11.

## Quick Pitches

**The Race for the Big Ten Crown:** With a four-game home sweep of Northwestern, Illinois built its lead atop the Big Ten standings to three games as the Illini aim for their first League title since 1998 and just their second since the Conference returned to single-division play in 1988. In a battle between two teams entering the weekend tied for second place, Iowa claimed three of four games from three-time defending Big Ten Champion Minnesota to keep pace with Illinois. The Hawkeyes stand only three games back with eight contests to play. Purdue has also moved into the race for the title, as the Boilermakers have moved up four spots in the last two weeks and currently stand in third place after splitting four games at Michigan. The top four teams in the League standings will square off next week as Minnesota hosts Illinois while Iowa will travel to Purdue.

**Record Win Totals:** Illinois (18-6) has already compiled 18 League victories and can equal the school record of 19 Conference wins, accomplished in 1990 and 1998, with just one more triumph. One more victory by Iowa (15-9) will mark the Hawkeyes most wins since the program racked up 22 triumphs in 1990, as the school also won 15 games in 2002.
