GAME NOTES

MICHIGAN NOTES

- Michigan is officially 25-22 all-time in the Big Ten Tournament and 6-5 in first round games. The Wolverines were playing for the first time as a No. 14 seed.
- Michigan finished with a 42-32 edge in rebounding.
- Nimari Burnett became the fourth Wolverine to reach 300 points in 2023-24.
- Terrance Williams II (15 points) led the team in scoring for the fifth time this year.

PENN STATE NOTES

- Penn State has won a Big Ten Tournament game for the fourth-straight year and for the sixth time in the last seven completed tournaments.
- The Nittany Lions have won four of their last six on the season.
- PSU improved to 6-0 this season when holding an opponent to under 60 points.
- Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year Ace Baldwin Jr. is averaging 2.72 steals per game, on pace to be the most by a Big Ten player in 31 years. He recorded three or more steals for the 16th time.
- Zach Hicks surpassed 200 three-point field goals for his career.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- In their only meeting this season, Penn State defeated Michigan, 79-73, on Jan. 7 at the Palestra in Philadelphia.
- Penn State has won three straight against Michigan; the Wolverines lead the all-time series, 39-17.
- The teams were meeting for the first time in the Big Ten Tournament since the 2013 First Round. PSU owns a 3-1 advantage in the Big Ten postseason.
