## GAME NOTES

### MARYLAND NOTES

- Maryland qualified for today's quarterfinals after defeating No. 13 Rutgers on Wednesday.
- Jahmir Young finished with 18 points, moving into 12<sup>th</sup>-place on Maryland's single-season scoring list with 652 points.
- Young ranks second nationally in career points (2,626) among active NCAA players.
- DeShawn Harris-Smith scored 16 points, capping a freshman season where he netted the most points (241) for a Maryland rookie since 2018-19.

### WISCONSIN NOTES

- Wisconsin claimed a 4-3 lead 1:08 into the game and never trailed from that point.
- The Badgers posted their largest margin of victory (+31) of the season.
- Wisconsin drained 16-of-25 three-pointers (64.0%), connecting on the second-most "threes" in a Big Ten Tournament game.
- The Badgers improved to 16-0 this season when holding opponents to 70 or fewer points.
- Wisconsin set a program record for most points (87) in a Big Ten Tournament game.
- The Badgers reached 20 wins in a season for the sixth time under Head Coach Greg Gard.
- AJ Storr scored in double figures for the 27th-straight game.

### MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Today's contest was the second meeting between Maryland and Wisconsin in the Big Ten Tournament. Wisconsin won a second-round game in 2018 at Madison Square Garden in New York.
- Maryland and Wisconsin were meeting for the 23<sup>rd</sup> time in a series the Badgers leads, 15-8. Wisconsin has won five of the last six encounters.
