### FIRST SERVE (TL;DR)

- USC has won **six national championships**. Three AIAW titles (1976, '77, '80) and three NCAA crowns (1981, 2002, '03).
- The Women of Troy own **eight conference championships**. Three in the Western Collegiate Athletic Association (1976, '77, '80), three in the Pac-10 (2000, '02, '03), and two in the Pac-12 (2011, '15).
- USC has played in the NCAA tournament **39 times**; twice under fifth-year head coach **Brad Keller** (2022, '23).
- USC is 129-43 (.750) all-time in postseason matches with an 83-36 (.697) record in the NCAA tournament. USC is 34-5 in NCAA first-round matches.
- Since the NCAA expanded to a 64-team field in 1998, USC has advanced to 12 regional championship matches, seven national semifinals (final four), and two national finals (both victories).
- The Trojans have previously played in three other conferences: the West Coast Athletic Association (1976-84), the Pac-West Conference (1985), and the Pac-10 Conference (1986-2010), which expanded and was later renamed the Pac-12 (2011-23).
- USC will play its **first season** as a member of the Big Ten Conference in 2024 and was picked to finish seventh in the Big Ten preseason coaches poll.

### HEAD COACH BRAD KELLER

- USC is led by fifth-year head coach **Brad Keller** who has the unique experience of having coached both men's and women's programs at both USC and UCLA. Overall, Keller is **63-47 (.573)** as the Trojans' head coach.
- Keller is the seventh head coach in program history.

### SENIOR SETTER MIA TUANIGA

- Tuaniga has been the Trojans' starting setter for each of the last three seasons and has amassed 3,309 career assists to rank eighth in school history.
- She was selected to the **Big Ten Preseason All-Conference Team**.
- She is a two-time All-Pac-12 choice and a two-time AVCA All-Pacific South Region Team selection. She was the Pacific South's Freshman of the Year in 2021 and earned AVCA All-America honorable mention in 2022.

### GRADUATE OUTSIDE HITTER ALLY BATENHORST

- Batenhorst is a 2024 graduate of Nebraska and transferred to USC.
- She was a 2022 Big Ten Distinguished Scholar in beach volleyball and earned CSC At-Large Academic All-District honors.
- A two-time NCAA runner-up with the Huskers (2021, '23).

### GALEN CENTER

- USC hosts its home matches at the Galen Center, which opened in 2006. The Women of Troy are 204-56 (.785) at the 10,000-seat arena.
- The Galen Center has hosted NCAA first and second round matches 11 times and was host to the 2013 NCAA regional championship.

### B1G RECORDS

- The Women of Troy are a combined 207-129-1 against the other 17 members of the Big Ten in its current alignment.
- USC is 165-111 all-time against the three former Pac-12 schools that will accompany the Trojans on their move to the Big Ten: Oregon (56-20), Washington (45-33), and crosstown rival UCLA (64-58).
- The Trojans are 42-18-1 against the 14 incumbent league members but has never faced Iowa or Rutgers. USC holds either a winning record or is even in all-time matches with 11 of the 12 Big Ten schools it has previously faced and trails in the all-time series only to Wisconsin (3-5).
- Not including former Pac-12 schools, USC's first-ever Big Ten opponent was Maryland (a 2-0 win on Dec. 9, 1976, in Austin, Texas); its last Big Ten foe was Purdue (a 3-1 win on Sept. 15, 2023, in West Lafayette, Ind.).

## USC HEAD COACH BRAD KELLER



Brad Keller is in his fifth season as USC's head coach. He was hired as the seventh coach in program history on February 20, 2020, and holds a **63-47 (.573) career record** at Troy.

Keller coached the Trojans to their 39th NCAA tournament appearance in 2023, the program's second consecutive appearance in the national tourney under his direction. He was previously the associate women's head coach at UCLA in 2019. Before that, he served six years (2013-18) as an assistant coach for the UCLA men's volleyball program. While on staff, Keller coached 10 All-Americans and helped the Bruins reach the NCAA national semifinals in 2016 and a national runner-up finish in 2018. According to *Volleyball Magazine* rankings, Keller helped recruit four top-ranked classes at UCLA: 2013, '14, '17, and '18.

On the national level, Keller has served as a coach for the U.S. Youth National Team programs. He was the head coach of the A1 U.S. Boys' Youth Team that won silver at the 2018 NORCECA U19 Continental Championship. Keller was also the U.S. Youth National Team's associate head coach in 2016 and 2017; and served as an assistant coach in 2014 and 2015.

Keller's collegiate coaching career began at USC where he served as an assistant coach for the Trojans for four seasons (2007-10). In 2009, USC won the MPSF Tournament and finished as the NCAA runner-up. Among the outstanding Trojan men that he coached were Murphy Troy, Tony Ciarelli, Tri Bourne, and brothers Riley and Maddison McKibbin.

Keller joined the UC Irvine men's program for the 2011 season as an assistant coach where he helped the Anteaters to a No. 3 national ranking and a semifinal appearance in the MPSF tournament. In the fall of 2011, Keller moved to the women's side of the sport and spent that season as an assistant coach at UConn. In the spring of 2012, Keller was named an assistant coach for the Santa Clara women's volleyball program. He helped the Broncos through the spring season before he was hired by the UCLA men's program that summer.

Prior to joining the collegiate coaching ranks, Keller was the owner, director, and a coach of Bay to Bay, a boys' volleyball club in Northern California, from 2000-06. His club won a pair of silver medals at the Junior Olympics and produced numerous NCAA Division I student-athletes. In the summer of 2006, he served as an assistant coach with the U.S. Men's Junior National Team.

Keller's other coaching experience includes two seasons (1995-96) as an assistant with the girls' team at Del Mar High School in San Jose, Calif.; and as head coach in 1999 of the girls' junior high team at Harvard-Westlake High School in North Hollywood, Calif.

As a student-athlete, Keller played outside hitter and defensive specialist at Loyola Marymount for two seasons (1999-2000) before the school stopped sponsoring the sport. He received his bachelor's degree in graphic design with a minor in marketing from LMU in 2002.

Keller attended Bellarmine Prep in San Jose, Calif., where he was the CIF Central Coast Section MVP in 1998. His younger brother Jarod played libero for the Stanford men's volleyball program. Keller was born Dec. 30, 1979.
