

## SCHEDULE OF EVENTS & RESULTS

MINNEAPOLIS, Minn. - Michigan women's tennis won its second Big Ten Tournament Championship on Sunday with a 4-3 victory over top-seeded Northwestern at the Baseline Tennis Center. The Wolverines captured their first conference tournament title since 2015.

Michigan's Chiara Lommer defeated Northwestern's Maddie Lipp 6-3, 3-6, 6-4 on court 2 in the decisive match to give the Wolverines the title.

After Northwestern claimed the doubles point, Michigan's Kate Fahey won her match against Erin Larner 6-3, 3-6, 6-4 on court 1. The Wolverines also claimed wins on courts 3 and 4 as Brienne Minor and Alyvia Jones won 6-1, 6-3 and 6-2, 6-4, respectively.

With the win, Michigan earns the conference's automatic berth to the NCAA Championships, which will take place May 17-28 at Wake Forest University in Winston-Salem, N.C.
