GAME NOTES

MARYLAND

- Entered today's quarterfinals ranked No. 15 in the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches polls.
- Shot 69 percent (11-of-16) from the floor in the second quarter and shot 62 percent (8-for-13) in the closing quarter.
- Suffered just its sixth loss in 28 games at the Big Ten Tournament.
- Sarah Te-Biasu scored a game-high 25 points in 40 minutes of action.

MICHIGAN

- Michigan won its second game in as many days (defeated Washington yesterday) to earn a spot in tomorrow's semifinals.
- Recorded its third win against a nationally-ranked opponent this season.
- Surpassed 90 points for the sixth time this year.
- Went on a 16-3 run in the third quarter to build upon a four-point halftime lead.
- Finished with an 18-2 advantage in fast break points.
- Featured three players with 20+ points — Jordan Hobbs (23 points), Syla Swords (22) and Olivia Olson (20).

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- No. 5 seeds now own a 15-14 advantage over No. 4 seeds in the Big Ten Tournament.
- Maryland still leads the all-time series against Michigan, 12-5.
